Important events of March 25

- **421:** The city of Venice in Italy was founded.
- **1306:** Robert the Bruce was made the new king of Scotland.
- 1609: Henry Hudson embarks on an exploration for Dutch East India Co. at Pulicat.
- 1655: Christian Higgins discovered Saturn's largest satellite, Titan.
- **1668:** Horse racing organized for the first time in America.
- 1700: England, the Netherlands, and France signed the second abolition agreement.
- 1788: The first advertisement in the Indian language Bengali was published in the newspaper 'Calcutta Gazette'.
- **1807:** *The first railway passenger service started in England.*
- **1807:** The Slave Trade Act was abolished in the British Empire.
- 1814: Netherlands Bank established.
- **1821:** *Greece gained independence from Türkiye.*
- 1883: Launching of the world's most modern oceanographic research vessel 'Sagar Kenya'.
- **1896:** *Modern Olympic Games started in Athens, the capital of Greece.*
- **1898:** Swami Vivekananda accepted Sister Nivedita as his disciple.
- 1898: Dalpatrai (Dalpatram Dahyabhai Trawadi), modern Gujarati poet, passed away.
- 1901: About 60 people died when the Rock Island Train derailed near Marshalltown, America.
- **1911:** *L. D. Swamikannu publishes "Manual of Indian Chronology" in Bombay.*
- **1916:** *S. M. Pandit, a famous painter, was born.*
- 1920: Sardar Sambhaji Chandrojirao Angre, politician and farmer, was born.
- **1924:** *Greece declared itself a republic.*
- 1927: Leslie Claudius, India field hockey (Olympic-gold-1948, 52, 56), was born.
- 1928: S. R. Kulkarni, leader of dock workers, was born.
- 1931: 50 killed in riots in India; Gandhi assaulted.
- 1931: Ganesh Shankar Vidyarthi martyred in Hindu-Muslim riot at Kanpur. He was also the Editor of weekly 'Pratap'.

- 1933: Vasantrao Gowarikar, space scientist, was born.
- 1954: India's first S-55 helicopter landed in Delhi.
- 1975: Saudi Arabia's ruler King Faisal was assassinated by his nephew Prince Faisal bin Mussad.
- 1983: Modern oceanographic research ship of the world 'Sagar Kanya' landed for the first time in the sea.
- 1987: The Permanent Secretariat of SAARC countries was opened in Kathmandu, the capital of Nepal.
- 1987: Marxist-led alliance gets majority in Kerala and West Bengal elections .
- 1989: India's first super-computer X-MP-14 of US made was dedicated to the nation.
- 1990: Lakshadweep Council elections.
- 1991: 1991 census report released; India has 844 million people.
- **1994:** Buta Singh exonerated by the Akal Takht after 9 years.
- 1995: Famous boxer Mike Tyson was released from jail after three years of imprisonment.
- 1996: 31st Jnanpith award presented to M.T. Vasudevan Nair at Trivandrum by Dr. Karan Singh.
- 1996: CBI gives a clean chit to PM Rao in the St. Kitts case.
- 1997: Justice Jagdish Saran Verma sworn in as Chief Justice of India.
- 1997: Jagdish Sharan Verma became the 27th Chief Justice of India.
- 1998: Yashwant Sinha, Finance Minister, and Railway Minister Nitish Kumar present the interim budgets for 1998-99.
- 1998: NASA launched spacecraft S-206.
- 1999: Arathi Ponnappa, Former National tennis champion, called it quits from competitive tennis in Bangalore.
- **2000:** Rupali Repale, a 17-year-old Indian swimmer, swam across Robben Island in South Africa. She is the youngest swimmer to swim in the bay.
- 2003: Capture of Iraq's Euphrates Bridge and Saddam Canal.
- 2005: The United Nations Security Council approved a peacekeeping force for Sudan.
- 2007: Team India out of World Cup Cricket.
- 2008: Tata Group's Pune-based firm Communication Research Laboratories allied with international firm Yahoo.
- 2011: The Coinage Bill 2011, passed in the Lok Sabha of India, provided for seven years of imprisonment for tearing a currency note or smelting a coin.
- 2013: Establishment of Manipur and Meghalaya High Court.
- 2017: Tanushree Pareek of Bikaner, Rajasthan made the country and the state proud by becoming the country's first woman officer of the Border Security Force (BSF).
