Important events of March 9

- 1500: Pedro Cabral departs from Portugal with 13 ships to India.
- 1776: Publication of Adam Smith's famous book on economics, 'The Wealth of Nations'.
- 1796: Napoleon Bonaparte married Josephine, his first wife.
- **1822:** *Charles Egg Graham patented the first denture.*
- **1858:** Bahadurshah Jafar II, the last Mughal Emperor, was deported to Rangoon under the offense for rising of the first Indian Mutiny in 1857.
- **1860:** *Japan appointed its ambassador to America for the first time.*
- **1861:** Currency of 50, 100 and 1000 dollars were introduced.
- **1897:** Fans started calling the team 'Indians' (in 1915 it became official).
- 1916: Germany declared war against Portugal.
- 1918: The Russian Bolshevik Party became the Communist Party.
- 1931: The Tories decide not to attend future round table talks on India in London.
- 1945: World War II- US B-29 bombers struck Tokyo, Japan. More than 1 lakh people died in it.
- 1959: The Barbie doll made its debut at the American International Toy Fair in New York.
- 1961: Successful launch of Russian spacecraft Sputnik 9 with a human dummy and a dog.
- 1961: Vishnu Sahay was appointed as the Cabinet Secretary of India. He held this office till 15-04-1962.
- **1966:** *India yields to Sikh demand for Punjab-speaking state.*
- 1989: Yasser Arafat, PLO Chairman, arrives on a two-day state visit to India.
- 1990: Lalu Prasad Yadav to form JD Ministry in Bihar.
- 1992: Poet-writer Dr. Harivansh Rai Bachchan awarded the first Saraswati Award by the Vice President of India at a function organized by the K. K. Birla Pratishthan in New Delhi.
- 1993: AIADMK severs alliance with the Congress in Tamil Nadu.
- 1996: Chaudhary Randhir Singh appointed Governor of Sikkim.
- 1997: Bangladesh and Chakma refugee leaders sign a historic agreement for repatriation of the 50,000 refugees sheltered in six camps in Tripura for the past 11 years.

- 1998: Vishwanathan Anand, Chess legend, wins the Super GrandMaster Title.
- 1999: Rabri Devi is sworn in Chief Minister of Bihar for the second time.
- 2004: Pakistan in 2004 2000 km. Successfully test-fired surface-to-air missile 'Shaheen-2' (Hatf-6) with a strike range of .
- 2005: Thaksin Shinawatra was elected Prime Minister of Thailand for the second term in 2005.
- 2007: Indian doctors in Britain won a legal victory over discriminatory immigration rules.
- 2008: Goa Governor S.C. Zameer assumed additional charge of Governor of Maharashtra.

- 1454: Amerigo Vespucci, an Italian merchant, explorer, and navigator.
- 1824: Amasa Leland Stanford, an American industrialist, and politician. He is the founder of Stanford University.
- **1836:** Navalram Pandya, a Gujarati critic, playwright, poet, essayist, editor, educationist, and a social reformer.
- 1863: Laxman Bapuji Kolhatkar (Bhaurao), famous singer and actor of Marathi theater, was born.
- 1902: Edward Durell Stone, US architect (US Embassy, New Delhi), was born.
- 1915: India's famous Hindi litterateur Dr. Nagendra was born.
- 1930: Renowned Indian jurist and former Attorney General of India Soli Jahangir Sorabji was born.
- 1934: Russian Soviet pilot and cosmonaut Yuri Gagarin was born.
- 1934: Yuri Gagarin, a Soviet Air Forces pilot and cosmonaut who became the first human to journey into outer space.
- 1938: Famous children's writer and editor Harikrishna Devsare was born.
- 1943: Robert Fischer, an American chess grandmaster
