Important events of March 14

- 1647: France, Cologne, Bavaria, and Sweden signed a truce after the Thirty Years' War.
- 1910: Dalai Lama makes a rare state visit to the Viceroy of Calcutta.
- 1912: Italy's King Vittorio Emmanuel III was fatally injured in an attack.
- 1914: Türkiye and Serbia signed a peace treaty.
- 1931: India's first talking film "Alam Ara" was screened in Mumbai.
- 1955: Prince Mahendra became the king of Nepal.
- 1965: The Israeli Cabinet agreed to restore diplomatic relations with West Germany.
- 1958: Royal family in Monaco Princess Grace gave birth to a son, in her joy a 101-gun salute was given in Monaco.
- 1976: America conducted nuclear tests in Nevada.
- 1983: OPEC, a group of oil producing countries, cut oil prices for the first time in 23 years.
- **1990:** *Akash' missile tested successfully*.
- 1992: NTR expels Upendra and six others from Telugu Desam Party.
- 1993: India seeks Interpol's assistance in investigating the sources of bomb blasts in Bombay.
- 1994: Narsinha Rao, Prime Minister, arrives in London for a 4-day official visit.
- 1995: Keshubai Patel (Gujarat), J.B. Patnaik (Orissa) and Manohar Joshi, the 12th (Maharashtra) CMs, elected.
- 1997: Border Security Force discovers a 34-meter long tunnel in the Ajnala Sub-sector of the Punjab border with Pakistan.
- 1998: Sonia Gandhi takes over as the Congress(I) president from Sitaram Kesri.
- 1999: Arjun Atwal won the Indian Open Golf in Calcutta.
- 1988: 'Pi Day', a special day for mathematics lovers, was celebrated for the first time.
- 1998: Sonia Gandhi became Congress President for the first time.
- 1999: Carlos Moyá of Spain became the world number one tennis player.

- 2004: Amendment of the Constitution in 2004 to provide legal recognition to private property in China.
- 2008: Victory Group acquired Britain's famous switchgear manufacturing company 'Craig & Derricott' in 2008.
