Important events of March 16

- **1521:** Ferdinand Magellan traveled the world to the Philippines.
- 1527: Rana Sangram Singh, King of Mewar, attacked Mughal Emperor Babur near Kanwa at Agra.
- 1528: A battle fought between Rana Sanga and Babur at Fatehpur Sikri, where Rana Sang was defeated.
- **1690:** *King Louis XIV of France sent troops to Ireland.*
- **1846:** According to the Treaty of Amritsar, the suzerainty of Kashmir was subdued under Gulab Singh, the Hindu king of Jammu.
- 1911: Gopal Krishna Gokhale proposed to make primary education compulsory in India.
- 1912: Gandhiji commends Gokhale's attempts for abolition of the indenture system.
- **1922:** *England recognized Egypt.*
- 1928: C.V. Raman announced his discovery of "new radiation" to an assembly of scientists at Bangalore.
- 1937: Mumbai High Court ruled that Dalits have the right to drink water from Chavdar Lake at Mahad.
- 1939: Germany occupied Czechoslovakia.
- 1939: Subroto Mukherjee became the first Indian Officer to command a squadron when he took over No.1.
- **1942:** The V-2 rocket was launched, but it exploded at the same time.
- 1946: India calls Attlee's independence offer contradictory, 'a propaganda move'.
- 1959: Iraq and the Soviet Union signed an economic and technological agreement.
- **1966:** Judge Amal Kumar Sarkar became the Chief Justice of India. He held this office till 29/06/1966.
- 1966: Amal Kumar's government became the 8th Chief Justice of India.
- 1966: America launched the manned spacecraft "Gemini 8".
- 1976: Harold Wilson, who was the Prime Minister of Britain for eight years and the leader of the Labor Party for 13 years, surprised everyone by resigning in 1976.

- 1977: Sixth General Election of India begins.
- 1978: America conducted nuclear tests in Nevada.
- 1982: Russia announced in 1982 that it would stop deploying new nuclear missiles in Western Europe.
- 1986: Internationally wanted criminal Charles Sobharaj and 6 other prisoners escape from Tihar Jail.
- **1989:** A 4400-year-old mummy was found in the pyramid of Chipoz in Egypt.
- 1992: Satyajit Ray, veteran film producer and director, was presented the honorary Oscar by a three-member Oscar committee at a Calcutta nursing home.
- 1993: Central government introduces pension scheme for 170 million EPF subscribers.
- 1995: K. Karunakaran resigns as CM of Kerala; Finance Minister presents Central Budget.
- 1995: NASA astronaut Norman Russian became the first American to visit the space station Mir.
- 1998: Chinese President Jiang Zemin was re-elected President for the next term.
- 1997: The first batch of three Russian-made Sukhoi-30 combat aircraft reaches India.
- 1997: Saidian Shafi, correspondent, Ankhon Dekhi', TV news magazine, and his personal security officer killed by militants in Srinagar.
- 1998: Sonia Gandhi is elected chairperson of the Congress(I) Parliamentary Party.
- 1999: The Shiromani Akali Dal creates a record by unanimously electing Bibi Jagir Kaur Begowal as the first woman president of the SGPC.
- **2000:** *Rabri Devi, Bihar Chief Minister, wins trust vote.*
- 2001: Nelson Mandela awarded the Gandhi Peace Prize.
- 2005: Kofi Annan, Secretary-General of the United Nations, nominated Supachayi Panichpakri as the new President of UNCTAD
- **2006:** *Three months after the elections, Iraq's new parliament took oath.*
- 2008: Pervez Musharraf signed the death warrant of Sarabjit Singh, an Indian citizen who was sentenced to death in Pakistan.
- 2014: The people of Crimea voted in favor of leaving Ukraine and joining Russia.

- 1599: Shahaji Raje Bhosale, father of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj, was born.
- 1693: Malhar Rao Holkar, a subhedar of the Maratha Empire.
- 1750: Caroline Herschel, a German astronomer.
- 1751: James Madison, 5th President of the United States.
- 1789: Georg Ohm, a German physicist, and mathematician.
- 1860: Dr. W.M. Haffkine, great scientist, bacteriologist and professor, was born at Odessa in Russia.
- 1877: Nanalal Dalpatram Kavi, famous poet, Gujarati litterateur and Headmaster, was born.

- 1880: Parshuram Rajshekhar Basu, famous Bengali writer, was born.
- 1901: Pralhad Balacharya Gajendragadkar, Chief Justice of Supreme Court of India, was born.
- 1901: Freedom fighter Potti Sriramulu, a follower of Gandhiji, was born.
- 1902: A. Appadorai, educationist and author, was born at Angadipuram, Kerala.
- 1906: India's well-known educationist and Hindi litterateur Ambika Prasad Divya was born.
- 1910: Iftikhar Ali Khan Pataudi, cricketer (Nawab of Pataudi sr, England & India), was born in Pataudi, Punjab.
- 1911: Josef Mengele, a German Schutzstaffel officer, and physician during World War II.
- 1929: A. K. Ramanujan, an Indian poet, and scholar of Indian literature.
