## **Important events of March 19**

- **1831:** In America, the first bank robbery took place at the City Bank of America in New York, in which \$245,000 was looted.
- 1848: Lokhitwadi started his column 'Shatpatra' in the newspaper named 'Prabhakar'.
- **1866:** about 750 people died when the Monarch, a ship full of intruders, sank in Liverpool.
- 1877: Australia defeated England by 45 runs in the first international cricket test match.
- **1895:** The Lumière brothers recorded the first footage from their newly patented cinematograph.
- 1920: The US Senate voted to join the League of Nations.
- **1935:** *British fire on 20,000 Muslims, killing 23.*
- 1927: There was a bloody conflict between Nazis and Communists in Germany.
- **1944:** Azad Hind Fauj hoisted the national flag in North-East India.
- 1953: For the first time, the Academy Awards were telecast on television.
- 1954: The first helicopter S-55 arrived at Bombay by sea.
- 1962: Raja Kelkar Museum, which belonged to Dinkar Gangadhar Kelkar, was opened for the people.
- **1965:** *Indonesia nationalized all foreign oil companies.*
- 1972: A peace and friendship agreement signed between India and Bangladesh.
- 1977: France conducted nuclear tests on Mururoa Island.
- 1982: Britain and the Vatican established diplomatic relations after a gap of 400 years.
- 1982: President's rule in Assam.
- 1990: The first women's world ice hockey competition was held in Ottawa, the capital of Canada.
- **1990:** Madhu Dandavate, Union Finance Minister, submits Rs. 7,206 crore deficit budget with a mixed bag of new levies and concessions.
- 1994: the world's largest omelet of 1383 square feet size was prepared from 1 lakh 60 thousand eggs in Yokohama, Japan.
- 1996: Reunification of Bosnia-Herzegovina's capital, Bosnia-Herzegovina.
- 1996: Election Commission announces dates of Lok Sabha elections (Apr. 27, May 2, 7 & 21) and

Assembly elections in Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Haryana, West Bengal, Assam & Pondicherry.

- 1997: BJP and BSP agree for a coalition government in Uttar Pradesh.
- 1998: BJP-led coalition government is sworn in. Atal Behari Vajpayee became the second time Prime Minister of India.
- 1999: The banned Maoist Communist Centre kills 34 Bhumihars at Senari village in Jehanabad district in Bihar.
- 1999: Resignation of European Commission President Jacques Santer from his post.
- 2000: Bill Clinton, US President, arrives to a warm welcome in India. This was the first presidential visit of a US head in two decades.
- 2001: Britain's House of Lords rejected the proposal to extradite musician Nadeem.
- **2004:** America sued China for the first time in the World Trade Organization.
- 2005: Pakistan successfully tested the "Shaheen-II" missile.
- 2008: Donkupar Roy took the oath of office and secrecy as the new Chief Minister of Meghalaya.
- 2008: Pakistan President Pervez Musharraf postponed Sarabjit's execution till April 30.

- 1900: Jean Frederic Joliot-Curie, a French physicist.
- 1919: D. K. Pattammal, an Indian Carnatic musician and a playback singer.
- 1982: Eduardo Saverin, a Brazilian entrepreneur, and angel investor.
