Important events of March 20

- 1351: Sultan Mohammad bin Tughlaq of Delhi died.
- **1602:** *Establishment of the Dutch East India Company.*
- 1739: Nadir Shah captured Delhi Sultanate.
- 1739: Nadir Shah plundered Mayurasana and Navratna from Delhi and sent them to Iran.
- **1854:** *The Republican Party of America formed.*
- 1904: C. F. Andrews came to India to join the freedom movement with Mahatma Gandhi.
- 1915: Albert Einstein introduced 'the theory of relativity'.
- 1916: Albert Einstein's book General Theory of Relativity was published.
- **1920:** The first flight between London and South Africa started.
- **1956:** Tunisia gained independence from France.
- 1956: The Soviet Union conducted nuclear tests.

- 1966: The Football World Cup, which was kept on exhibition in the Central Hall of London Westminster, was stolen in 1966.
- 1977: Prime Minister Indira Gandhi was defeated in the Lok Sabha elections.
- 1981: Former Argentine President Isabel Peron was sentenced to eight years in prison in 1981.
- 1982: France conducted nuclear tests.
- 1987: NASA launched Pala B2P.
- 1987: The anti-AIDS drug AZT, the first drug given by the US government for the treatment of AIDS, was approved by the Food and Drug Administration in 1987.
- 1990: Namibia's independence was declared at midnight on this day.
- 1991: Begum Khaleda Zia became the President of Bangladesh.
- 1995: poisonous gas leaked in the subway in Tokyo, killing about 15 people and injuring thousands.
- 2003: America started attacking Iraq.

- 2006: Afghanistan's Foreign Minister claimed that Osama bin Laden was hiding in Pakistan.
- 2010: 'World Sparrow Day' was celebrated for the first time to save the bird named Gauraiya.
- 2015: A Solar eclipse, equinox, and a super moon all occur on the same day.
