## **Important events of March 27**

- World Theatre Day
- 1668: England's ruler Charles II handed over Bombay to the East India Company.
- 1721: Spain and France signed the Madrid Agreement.
- 1794: Establishment of the US Navy.
- 1794: The American Congress approved the establishment of the Navy in the country.
- **1841:** *The first steam fire engine was successfully tested in New York.*
- 1845: Wilhelm Conrad Von Roentgen, professor and first nobel prize winner, was born at Lennep, Germany.
- 1855: Abraham Gesner patented kerosene (kerosene).
- 1871: The first international rugby match was played between Scotland and England.
- 1878: Britishers sent Indian soldiers to Malta considering that the Russian would attack.
- 1884: The first long distance telephone conversation took place between Boston and New York.
- 1898: Syed Ahmad Khan, great social reformer, educationist, journalist, leader and one of the most eminent builders of Modern India, passed away at Aligarh.
- 1899: The first international radio broadcast was made between France and England by Italian inventor G. Marconi.
- **1901:** *America captured Philippines rebel leader Emilio Aguinaldo.*
- 1933: Japan separated itself from the League of Nations.
- 1942: Gandhiji meets Sir Stafford Cripps in New Delhi; later declares Cripps proposals to be a "post-dated cheque".
- 1944: In the European country Lithuania, about two thousand Jews were murdered.
- 1956: The US government confiscated the communist newspaper Daily Worker.
- 1958: Nikita Khrushchev became President of Soviet Russia.
- **1961:** *Celebrating the first World Theater Day started.*
- **1966:** *Indira Gandhi meets Johnson in Washington.*

- 1977: The government revoked the national Emergency promulgated on Dec. 3, 1971.
- 1977: N. Sanjeeva Reddy was elected Speaker of the Lok Sabha.
- 1977: The world's worst plane crash took place in Tenerife, in which about 600 people were killed.
- 1977: European fighter aircraft Eurofighter made its first flight.
- **1982:** *A.F.M.A.Chowdhary was appointed President of Bangladesh.*
- 1989: America's test of an "anti-missile satellite" in space failed.
- 1989: T. N. Seshan was appointed as the Cabinet Secretary of India. He held this office till 23-12-1989.
- 1990: A 10-member Progressive Democratic Front Ministry led by Churchill Alemao sworn in Goa.
- 1990: 21 people die as a bus accidentally touched a high voltage wire in Kharagpur India.
- 1991: Chautala recommends Assembly dissolution.
- **1992:** *India signs Friendship Treaty with Ukraine.*
- 1993: Hari Singh from Haryana hijacks an IA plane, but surrender after 8 hours.
- **1996:** President and Governors of respective states issue notifications for elections to the 11th Lok Sabha and 6 State Assemblies.
- **1997:** *40 more inducted in UP cabinet, raising strength to 45.*
- 1997: South African President Nelson Mandela arrives in New Delhi on official visit.
- 1999: World No. 2 Viswanathan Anand won the title with a round to spare in the rapid section of the Amber rapid and blindfold chess tournaments in Monte Carlo.
- 1999: The first macro virus "Melissa" was reported.
- 2000: After more than two-and-a-half-years, a Delhi court resumes trial in the St. Kitts forgery case following Delhi High Court's order upholding the lower court's verdict on framing of charges.
- **2000:** *Mohun Bagan lifts title in the National Football league in Calcutta.*
- 2003: Russia tested the deadly Topol RS-12M ballistic missile.
- 2006: Yasin Malik demanded a referendum in Kashmir.
- 2008: Space shuttle Endeavor successfully returned safely to Earth.

- **1863:** *Henry Royce, he founded Rolls-Royce.*
- 1899: Lakshmi N. Menon, an Indian freedom fighter and politician.

- 1922: French writer Stephane Val was born.
- 1923: Leela Dubey, a famous anthropologist and feminist scholar, was born.
- 1936: Indian politician Banwari Lal Joshi was born.

- 1954: Hemant Joshi, translator of French poets and professor of journalism, was born.
- 1985: Ram Charan Teja, an Indian film actor, producer, and entrepreneur.
