Important events of March 6

- 1521: Ferdinand Magellan reached Guam.
- 1775: Raghunath Rao signed a treaty of Surat with the British ending the first Anglo-Maratha War.
- **1840:** The Baltimore College of Dental Surgery became the first dental college.
- **1869**: Dmitri Mendeleev presented the first periodic table to the Russian Chemical Society.
- **1886:** The first nurses' magazine, Nightingale, was published in 1886.
- 1902: The famous football club 'Madrid Club' of Spain was established.
- **1915:** Gandhi and Rabindranath Tagore met for the first time at Shantiniketan.
- 1924: Ismet Inonu formed a new government in Türkiye.
- 1944: during World War II, America, along with the Allies, bombed Berlin heavily.
- **1947:** Churchill opposes troop withdrawal from India at London.
- **1947:** *Editing of Economic Times started from Bombay.*
- 1957: Ghana Independence Day.
- 1961: India's first financial daily newspaper 'The Economic Times' was launched in Bombay by the Times of India Group.
- 1967: Joseph Stalin's daughter Svetlana reached America in 1967 through the Russian Embassy in India.
- **1983:** The first football league was established in the United States.
- **1991:** Chandrasekhar resigns as PM.
- **1992:** *Michelangelo computer virus began to spread.*
- 1997: Indian Ocean Rim Association for Regional Cooperation (IOR-ARC) inaugurated in Mauritius.
- 1998: Virbhadra Singh formed the Congress government in Himachal Pradesh.
- 1999: President KR Narayan inaugurated the Millennium Celebrations of the world-famous Khajuraho Temple Group.
- 2000: India and China begin the first ever bilateral security dialogue in Beijing on global and regional issues of mutual Interest.

- 2000: Supreme Court ruled that the amount received as City Subsistence Allowance (CCA), Dearness Allowance (DA), and Housing Allowance (HRA) is taxable.
- 2003: An Algerian airliner crashed in Tamaraset, killing more than 102 passengers.
- 2005: India's first nuclear power plant was launched at Tarapur.
- **2008:** *Pakistan President Pervez Musharraf rejected the mercy petition of Sarabjit Singh in 2008.*

Famous People born on March 6

- 1475: Michelangelo, an Italian sculptor, painter, architect, and poet.
- 1508: Humayun, son of Babar, the ruler of the Mughal Empire, was born in 1508 in Kabul, the capital of Afghanistan.
- 1787: German physicist Joseph von Fraunhofer.
- **1812:** *Ishwar Chandra Gupta, a famous Indian Bengali poet, and writer.*
- 1903: Empress Kojun of Japan.
- 1915: Mohammed Burhanuddin, the 52nd Dai al-Mutlaq of Dawoodi Bohras.
- 1937: Valentina Tereshkova, a member of the Russian State Duma, engineer, and former cosmonaut. She is the first and youngest woman to have flown in space with a solo mission.
- 1945: Birth of Syed Ahmed, Indian politician, writer and Congress member in 1945.
- 1949: Pakistan Prime Minister Shaukat Aziz.
- 1965: Devaki Pandit, an Indian classical singer.
