Important events of March 7

- 321 AD: Roman Emperor Constantine I declared Sunday as a state day of rest, which was in line with Christian beliefs.
- 1774: Britain closed Boston Port to all commercial activities.
- 1835: a proposal was made to promote the propagation of European literature and science in India.
- **1854:** Charles Miller obtained a patent for a sewing machine.
- **1875:** Alexander Graham Bell invented the telegraph on this day.
- 1876: Alexander Graham Bell received a patent for his telephone invention.
- **1906:** Finland gave women the right to vote.
- 1911: Famous Hindi writer Sachchidanand Hiranand Vatsyayan Agyeya was born
- **1918:** Finland signed a friendship treaty with Germany.
- **1925:** *Mongolia was externally occupied by the Soviet Red Army.*
- 1936: World War II, Germany invaded the Rhineland, breaking the Treaty of Versailles.
- 1945: During World War II, American troops crossed the Rhine River in Germany.
- 1956: A gigantic steel tube plant opened in Jamshedpur. It was the first of its kind in India.
- **1959:** American pilot Melvin C. Garlow became the first pilot to fly a jet plane a distance of one lakh miles.
- 1969: Israel elected 70-year-old Golda Meir as its first female Prime Minister.
- **1971:** Sheikh Mujib-ur-Rahman called for the independence of Bangladesh.
- **1985:** the first antibody test for AIDS, the Elisa-type test, was started.
- **1994:** India and Iran sign three MoU in Tehran.
- **1996:** Union Cabinet clears decks for extending benefits of reservation to Dalit Christians.
- 1998: A. B. Vajpayee is elected leader of the BJP Parliamentary Party.

- 1999: 22 persons are killed and six injured when an AN-32 transport aircraft of the IAF crashes at Pappankulam near Indira Gandhi International Airport in south-west Delhi.
- 2006: The Lashkar-e-Taiba terrorist organization carried out a bomb blast in Varanasi, India.
- 2007: Pakistan and India agreed to help in the investigation on terrorism.
- 2008: Astronauts discovered a lake on Mars.
- 2009: NASA launched a telescope named Kepler into space from Cape Canaveral to search for Earth-like planets and life on them in the universe.
