Important events of March 8

- **1534:** *Bahadur Shah of Gujarat looted Chittorgarh.*
- 1535: Bahadur Shah captured the fort of Chittor and then marched against the Mughal emperor.
- 1673: Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj conquered the fort of Panhala.
- 1702: Queen Anne assumed power after the death of King William III of England.
- 1817: Establishment of the New York Stock Exchange (NYSE).
- 1907: The British House of Commons rejected the bill related to women's suffrage.
- 1908: Many women took part in a rally in New York in 1908 for better pay, shorter hours, and the right to vote.
- 1909: The American Socialist Party celebrated National Women's Day for the first time.
- 1910: In the International Women's Conference held in Copenhagen (Denmark), it was proposed to fix March 8 as International Women's Day.
- **1911:** *International Women's Day was celebrated for the first time in Europe.*
- 1921: Assassination of President Eduardo Dato while leaving the Parliament in Madrid, the capital of Spain.
- 1942: World War II- Japan conquered Rangoon, the capital city of Myanmar.
- 1948: Indian airline Air India International began its overseas service.
- 1948: Phaltan State merged with the Republic of India.
- **1957:** *Ghana joined the United Nations.*
- 1979: Philips launched the first compact disc.
- 1986: L.K. Advani was elected President of BJP.
- 1997: G. K. Moopanar was unanimously elected first president of Tamil Maanila Congress.
- 1998: Indian Airlines operates two international flights with all women crew.
- 1999: The President formally revokes the proclamation imposing Central rule in Bihar after this was decided by the Union Cabinet earlier in the day.
- **2000:** The Gujarat Government withdraws its January 3 notification, thus reimposing the ban on its employees from participating in RSS activities.

- **2004:** A new constitution was signed by Iraq's Governing Council.
- 2006: Russia withdrew its resolution on the Iran issue.
- 2008: The film Fear of Footpaths represented India at the Cairo International Festival for Children.
- 2013: North Korea ended all peace agreements with South Korea.

Famous People born on March 8

- 1833: Vishwanath Narayan Mandalik, famous journalist, writer and social reformer, was born.
- **1864:** Hari Narayan Apte, a well known Marathi writer who popularized social and historical themes in his novels. He presided over the 8th Marathi Sahitya Sammelan in 1912.
- 1879: Otto Hahn, a German chemist.
- 1886: Edward Calvin Kendall, an American chemist.
- 1889: First Chairman of 'Gandhi Memorial Fund', Gandhian leader, freedom fighter and first Chief Minister of Punjab, Gopi Chand Bhargava was born.
- 1889: Vishwanath Das, Indian politician and Chief Minister of Orissa province of British India, was born.
- 1897: Indian artist Damerla Rama Rao was born.
- 1931: Manohari Singh, an Indian saxophonist.
- 1932: Sudhira Das, an Indian engineer. She was the first female engineer from the state of Odisha.
- 1953: Vasundhara Raje Scindia, the first woman Chief Minister of Rajasthan, was born.
