Important events of April 10

- •1816: The United States federal government approved the establishment of a second bank there.
- **1866:** Henry Bergh founded the American Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals in New York City.
- •1868: In Ethiopia, British and Indian forces defeated the army of Tewodros II, killing 700 Ethiopians, while only two British-Indian soldiers were martyred.
- •1875: Swami Dayanand Saraswati founded the Arya Samaj.
- •1887: President Abraham Lincoln was reburied with his wife in Springfield, Illinois.
- •1889: Ram Chandra Chatterjee became the first Indian to fly in a hot balloon.
- •1912: The first and last voyage of the Titanic sailed from the port of Southampton, England.
- •1916: The first professional golf tournament was held.
- •1922: The historic Geneva Conference began.
- •1930: Synthetic rubber was produced for the first time.
- •1938: Austria became a state of Germany.
- •1955: Johann Salk successfully tested the first polio vaccine.
- •1959: Japan's then Crown Prince Akihito married Michiko.
- •1963: The submarine "USS Thresher" sank in the sea, killing 123 American sailors.
- •1972: About 5 thousand people died in the earthquake in Iran.
- •1973: Pakistan repealed the old constitution.
- **1982:** Successful launch of India's multi-purpose satellite INSAT-1A.
- •1998: Agreement concluded between Catholics and Protestants in Northern Ireland.
- •2001: Signing of the Tehran Declaration between India and Iran.
- **2003:** *America occupied Iraq.*
- 2008: The Supreme Court declared constitutional 27% reservations for students of Other Backward Classes (OBCs) in central educational institutions and educational institutions aided by the central government.

- •2010: All 96 people on board the plane of President Lech Kaczynski of the European country Poland died when it crashed.
- •2016: About 110 people died and more than 300 were injured in a massive fire at the Puttingal temple in Kollam district of Kerala.
- •2019: Scientists from the Event Horizon Telescope project announced the first-ever image of a black hole, located in the center of the M87 galaxy.
