Important events of April 12

- **1606:** *Great Britain recognized the Union Jack as its national flag.*
- •1621: Sikh Guru Teg Bahadur was born.
- **1801:** William Cray was appointed professor of Bengali language at Fort William College, Calcutta (now Kolkata).
- •1801: Ranjit Singh declared himself the Maharaja of Punjab.
- •1861: The civil war started in America.
- •1927: The British Cabinet supported granting women over 21 the right to vote.
- •1928: The German aircraft Bremen made the first successful east-west flight across the Atlantic Ocean.
- •1945: US President Franklin D. Roosevelt dies in office.
- •1946: French occupation of Syria ended.
- •1955: The polio vaccine developed by Dr. Jones Salk was declared safe and effective.
- •1961: The Soviet cosmonaut Yuri Gagarin became the first human to travel into outer space and perform the first manned orbital flight, Vostok 1.
- **1967:** *Kailashnath Wanchu became the 10th Chief Justice of India.*
- •1973: Sudan made its constitution.
- •1978: To commemorate the completion of 125 years of Indian Railways, the country's first double-decker train, Sinhagad Express, was run from Victoria Terminus of Bombay (now Mumbai) to Pune.

- •1992: The Giant Buddha statue was installed in Hussain Sagar Lake in Hyderabad.

- •1998: Girija Prasad Koirala appointed the new Prime Minister of Nepal.
- 2006: Cyprus President Tasos Papadopoulos visited India on a 6-day visit.

- •2007: Pakistan grants Iran gas pipeline to India.
- •2008: Three people, including two Indian engineers, were killed in a suicide attack on an Indian convoy in Afghanistan.
