- •1336: Harihar and Bukka established the Hindu kingdom of Vijayanagar.
- •1612: Shah Jahan, emperor of the Mughal Empire, married Mumtaz.
- •1831: Establishment of the University of Alabama.
- •1853: Asia's first train was run from Bombay to Tanna.
- •1859: Tatya Tope, leader of the 1857 Rebellion, was executed.
- •1898: Damodar Chapekar, assassinator British officer Rand, was executed.
- 1906: The earthquake and fire in San Francisco killed approximately 4,000 people.
- •1912: Carpathia arrived in New York with 705 survivors aboard the Titanic.
- •1917: Mahatma Gandhi selected Champaran in Bihar for Satyagraha.
- •1923: Yankee Stadium opened in the Bronx.
