- Indian Civil Service Day
- •753 **BC:**Romulus founded Rome.
- •1451: Bahlol Khan Lodi, founder of the Lodi dynasty, became the ruler of Delhi.
- •1526: Ibrahim Lodi was killed in the First Battle of Panipat between Babur, the ruler of the Mughal Empire, and Ibrahim Lodi.
- •1572: A military agreement was signed between France and England against Spain.
- •1654: Trade agreement signed between England and Sweden.
- •1720: Bajirao I succeeded Peshwa Balaji Vishwanath.
- •1739: A peace treaty was signed between Spain and Austria.
- •1782: The city of Bangkok was founded.
- •1938: Famous Urdu poet Mohammad Iqbal died in Lahore, Pakistan.
- •1941: *Greece surrendered to Nazi Germany.*
- •1945: The victory achieved on this day during the Second World War by the army of today's Soviet Union in its efforts to capture the city of Berlin and defeat Hitler is considered very important.
- •1960: Brasilia became the capital of Brazil.
- •1967: There was a military coup in Greece.
- 1972: John Young and Charles Duke, astronauts from the American spacecraft Apollo 16, landed on the moon.
- •1987: More than a hundred people died in a bomb blast in Colombo, the capital of Sri Lanka.
- •1996: Sanjay Thapar of the Indian Air Force was parachuted to the North Pole.
- 2000: Supreme Court ruled that a dependent widow has a right to the property of her parents.
