- World Book and Copyright Day
- •1635: The first public school in the United States, Boston Latin School, was founded in Boston.
- **1660:** The Treaty of Oliva was agreed between Sweden and Poland.
- **1661:** Coronation of British King Charles II in London.
- •1751: Gilbert Elliot Minto, Governor General of the East India Company, was born.
- •1774:British commander Colonel Chapman defeated the Rohilla army and captured Rohilkhand.
- •1891: Jews were expelled from Moscow, the capital of Russia.
- •1908: The North Atlantic Treaty was signed between Germany, Denmark, Britain, Sweden, Holland and France.
- •1921: Subhash Chandra Bose resigned from his job as an Indian Civil Servant in England and came back to India.
- •1935: European country Poland adopted the constitution.
- •1971: The Pakistan Army and Razakars massacred approximately 3,000 Hindu emigrants in the Mathabhanga area of East Pakistan (now Bangladesh).
