Important events of April 24

- National Panchayati Raj Day (INDIA) & Democracy Day (NEPAL)
- •1800: The world's best library, the Library of Congress, opened in the United States.
- •1815: The Gorkha Regiment, considered to be the first and bravest battalion of the Indian Army, completed 200 years on this day.
- •1877: Russia declared war on the Ottoman Empire.
- •1898: Spain declared war on America.
- •1915: German forces released chloroform gas in the Ypres region of the Flemish province of Belgium in 1915.
- •1920: Polish forces invaded Ukraine.
- •1926: The Treaty of Berlin was signed.
- •1954: Australia and the Soviet Union ended diplomatic relations.
- •1960: A terrible earthquake in South Persia killed about 500 people.
- •1967: Vladimir Komarov became the first astronaut to die for not opening a parachute on time.
- •1968: Mauritius joined the United Nations.
- •1970: The Gambia became a republic.
- •1970: The first Chinese satellite Dong Fang Hong was launched.
- •1990: Hubble telescope launched into space.
- •1993: Terrorists hijacked Indian Airlines Flight 427 from Delhi to Srinagar. All 141 passengers were released safely.
- •1998: The Indian cricket team won the Coca Cola Cup by defeating Australia by six wickets in Sharjah.
- •2002: Banks closed indefinitely in Argentina.
- •2006: Parliament restored in Nepal.
- •2013: A building collapsed in Dhaka, killing approximately 1,129 people and injuring more than 2,500.

- •1571: Sawai Raja Sur Singh Rathore, the king of the Marwar kingdom, India.
- •1922: Italian politician Susanna Agnelli was born.
- •1940: Former Governor of Mizoram Aziz Qureshi was born.
- •1956: Sharad Bobde, the 47th and current Chief Justice of India.
- •1956: Teejan Bai, an exponent of Pandavani, a traditional performing art form, from Chhattisgarh, India.
