### **Important events of April 28**

- Lawyers' Day (Odisha, India)
- •1701: John Norris of Britain met Aurangjeb at Parnela in South India.
- 1740: Baji Rao I aka Thorle BajiRao Peshwa passed away at Raverkhedi near the banks of the Narmada river near Khargone and his son Balaji Baji Rao was placed on his father's throne as the Peshwa.
- •1758: The Marathas defeated the Durrani Empire in the Battle of Attock and captured the city.
- •1788: Maryland became the seventh state to ratify the U.S. Constitution.
- •1829: The Parliament of the European country Netherlands passed new press laws.
- **1847:** George B. Vashon became the first black citizen to appear in a New York court in the United States.
- •1848: Utkal Gourab Madhusudan Das was born in Calcutta district in Orissa.
- •1910: In England, a pilot named Claude Graham White flew an aircraft at night for the first time.
- •1914: 181 people died in a coal mine accident in the Essels area of West Virginia, USA.
- •1916: BG Tilak founded the Indian Home Rule League in 1916.
- •1932: The development of a yellow fever vaccine for humans was announced in 1932.
- •1935: *Underground train 'Metro' started in Russia's capital Moscow in 1935.*
- •1936: Abdul Rashid 'Fida' (Kishtwari), great poet, was born.
- •1943: Netaji Subash Chandra Bose aligned the Japanese-German submarine at Madagascar.
- •1945: Italian dictator Benito Mussolini, his mistress Clara Petacci and some of his associates were murdered.
- •1952: The war between Japan and India ended.
- •1956: The last French soldier left Vietnam and returned home.
- •1964: Japan joined the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD).
- 1969: The then President of France Charles de Gaulle resigned from his post.
- •1974: Gaganvihari Lallubhai Mehta, famous economist, politician and journalist, passed away.

- •1986: Malayalam film `Chidambaram' directed by G. Aravindan wins best feature film award and Shyam Benegal bags the Best Director award for the Hindi film 'Trikal'.

- •1993: 30 football players died when a Zambian plane crashed in Libreville, Gabon.
- •1993: Troops storm police complex in Srinagar and free officials from the rebelling of 2000 policemen.
- •1995: 103 people died in a metro gas explosion in South Korea.
- •1995: 52 passengers died in a plane crash in Palaly, Sri Lanka.
- •1996: EC orders re-polling in 69 booths in four states.
- •1999: American scientist Dr. Richard Seed announced that he would create a human clone within a Year.
- •2001: American businessman Dennis Anthony created history by becoming the first space tourist.
- **2001:** *The first space tourist, Tennis Tito left for the space station.*
