Important events of April 4

- **1460:** *University of Basel in Switzerland was founded.*
- 1716: Wismar in northern Germany was captured by Russian and Prussian forces.
- 1722: Jacob Rogerwin explored eastern Ireland.
- 1818: The US Congress approved the inclusion of '13 red and white strips and 20 stars' in the national flag.
- 1858: After fighting with the British army led by Hughes Rose, Rani Lakshmi Bai of Jhansi left Jhansi reached Kalpi and later moved towards Gwalior.
- 1905: A massive earthquake struck the Kangra Valley, killing approximately 20,000 people.
- 1910: Philosopher Sri Aurobindo Ghosh arrived in Pondicherry (now Puducherry) where he opened a yoga and spiritual center.
- **1916:** The American Senate approved participation in World War I.
- **1941:** The Libyan city of Benghazi was captured by the German army.
- 1944: British forces captured Adil Ababa, Ethiopia.
- 1949: The North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) was established, a result of the early stages of the Cold War.
- 1949: Eleven countries in Western Europe together with the United States, established NATO.
- **1960:** The African country Senegal declared independence from France.
- 1968: James Earl Ray assassinated Martin Luther King Jr.
- 1968: Apollo Program NASA launched Apollo 6.
- 1968: American human rights activist Martin Luther King was assassinated on this day.
- 1975: Bill Gates and Paul Allen founded Microsoft in Albuquerque, New Mexico.
- 1975: Microsoft was founded as a result of an agreement between Bill Gates and Paul Allen.
- 1979: Former Prime Minister of Pakistan Zulfikar Ali Bhutto was sentenced to death.
- 1990: Lata Mangeshkar honored with Dadasaheb Phalke Award.
- 1994: Declaration of Tibetan boy Ugyen Thinley Dorje as the new Karmapa by Tibetan spiritual leader Dalai Lama.

- 1997: In terms of purchasing power, the World Bank declared India as the fifth largest economy of the world.
- 2006: New charges were leveled against deposed Iraqi President Saddam Hussein.
- 2008: Former Chief Minister of Delhi Madan Lal Khurana accepted BJP membership.
- 2008: Pakistan's new government removed Major General Nadeem from the post of Army Intelligence Chief.
- 2013: About 80 people were killed when an illegally constructed building collapsed in Thane, Maharashtra.
- 2013: In Thane, Maharashtra, 74 people were killed when an illegally constructed building collapsed.
- 2013: Nine people were killed in an axe murder case in Chhattisgarh.

- 1949: India's famous Bollywood actress Parveen Bobby was born in Junagadh, Gujarat.
