Important events of April 8

- **1801:** 128 Jews died in violence in Bucharest, the capital of Romania.
- 1831: Famous social reformer Raja Ram Mohan Roy arrived in England.
- 1838: The Great Western steam-powered ship sailed from Bristol, England, and arrived in New York a fortnight later. This is the first fireboat to cross the Atlantic Ocean.
- 1857: Mangal Pandey, a soldier of the 1857 rebellion, was executed.
- 1911: Dutch physicist Heike Onnes discovered superconductivity.
- 1912: more than 200 people drowned after two ships collided in the Nile River.
- 1921: Acharya Vinoba Bhave established Paunar Ashram at Wardha.
- 1929: Bhagat Singh and Batukeshwar Dutt bombed the Central Assembly in Delhi.
- 1946: The last meeting of the League of Nations, the predecessor of the United Nations.
- 1950: After the partition of India and Pakistan, both countries signed an agreement to safeguard the rights of minorities living in their respective countries. India and Pakistan sign the Liaquat-Nehru Agreement.
- 1959: Computer engineers met to develop a new programming language 'COBOL'.
- **1961:** 240 people died when the British ship Dara fell into the Persian Gulf.
- 1964: "Gemini-1" was launched.
- 1985: Border war started between India and Pakistan, it is also known as the Second Kashmir War.
- 1988: General Wen Shang Kun was elected President of China.
- 1993: The Republic of Macedonia joined the United Nations.
- 2003: the US military dropped bunker-busting bombs on Baghdad to track down Saddam Hussein, killing many civilians.
- 2005: An estimated 4 million people attended the funeral of Pope John Paul II.
- 2008: The governments of Andhra Pradesh and Karnataka declared Sikhs as a minority in their states.

- 1924: Kumar Gandharva, an Indian classical singer.
- 1928: Ranjit Desai, a popular Marathi writer from Maharashtra, India.
- 1938: Kofi Annan, a Ghanaian diplomat who served as the seventh Secretary-General of the United Nations.
- 1950: Bijay Mohanty, an Indian film actor of Odia Cinema.
- 1892: Historian Hemchandra Rai Choudhary was born.
