1. Europe becomes top spot for India's exports of petroleum products

According to the Commerce Ministry, India exported the highest amount of petroleum products (\$10.9 billion) to the Netherlands, followed by Singapore at \$5.7 billion, UAE at \$5.4 billion, US at \$5 billion, Australia at \$3.5 billion and Australia at \$3.2 billion. Exported. Overall, India exported petroleum products worth \$70.13 billion. In terms of crude oil imports, India received the highest quantity from Russia from April to January 2024, followed by Iraq, Saudi Arabia, UAE and the US.
