Important events of March 30

- Rajasthan Day
- 1665: Murarbaji died at Purandar fort during a battle with Dilerkhan.
- 1699: The Khalsa tradition was initiated by the Tenth Guru of Sikhism, Guru Gobind Singh.
- 1814: After defeating Napoleon Bonaparte, the British army moved towards Paris.
- 1822: Florida joined the American Republic.
- 1842: Dr. Crawford Long, an American surgeon, used ether for anesthesia during surgery.
- 1842: Ether was first used as an anesthetic.
- 1856: The Crimean War ended with the Treaty of Paris.
- 1856: Treaty of Paris ended the Crimean War.
- 1858: Hymen L. Lippmann registered the first patent for a pencil with an eraser attached.
- 1867: America purchased Alaska from Russia.
- 1908: Devika Rani, famous film actress, was born.
- 1913: B. S. Soman, first Admiral of India, was born.
- 1919: Mahatma Gandhi announces opposition to the Rowlatt Act.
- **1919:** The city of Düsseldorf in Germany was captured by the Belgian army.
- 1923: New financial measures come into force, including restoration of Salt Tax.
- 1929: Air postal service between India and England began.
- **1929:** Weekly postal service across 5,000-miles by airplane started between England and India serving India, Egypt, Palestine and Iraq in London.
- 1945: Dr. J. J. Rawal, joint director of Nehru Planetarium of Mumbai, was born.
- 1945: The Soviet Union invaded Austria.
- 1949: Rajasthan state was established on this day and Jaipur was made its capital.
- **1949:** The state of Rajasthan formed.
- 1949: New Union of Greater Rajasthan was ceremonially inaugurated by Patel when the existing

Union of Rajasthan was joined by four premier states of Bikaner, Jaipur, Jodhpur and Jaisalmer.

- **1950:** *Murray Hill invented the phototransistor.*
- **1963:** France conducted underground nuclear tests in the Iker region of Algeria.
- 1976: A huge demonstration took place in illegally occupied Palestine in the name of Land Day.
- 1977: Swami Agnivesh merged his 'Bhartiya Arya Sabha Party' into the Janata Party.
- **1981:** US President Reagan was attacked while passing by the hotel. He was fired on six bullets, the last bullet hit his chest.
- 1982: NASA's spacecraft Columbia returned to Earth after completing the STS-3 mission.
- **1988:** *Tamil Nadu beat Railways by an innings and 144 runs to win Ranji Trophy.*
- 1989: Waman Ganpat Behre `Sobat', editor of weekly, passed away.
- 1990: Constitution (64th) Amendment Bill to extend President's rule in Punjab collapses in Lok Sabha.
- 1992: Satyajit Ray received the honorary Oscar award.
- 1992: Indian filmmaker Satyajit Ray honored with the Oscar Award.
- **1993:** Air Time Committee Chief P.S. Deodhar and its members resign in protest against the implementation of the metro channel of Doordarshan.
- 1993: India forgoes Narmada loan balance because of World Bank's strict regulations.
- **1993:** Punjab beat Maharashtra by 120 runs to win Cricket's Ranji Trophy.
- **1993:** *S. M. Pandit, a famous painter, passed away.*
- 1994: Bombay beat Bengal by 8 wickets to win Cricket's Ranji Trophy.
- **1994:** *Exim Policy streamlined to attract the exporting community.*
- 1994: G-15 summit in New Delhi decides to set up a trade panel.
- 1996: Congress I splits in Tamil Nadu. Group led by G.K. Moopanar makes alliance with DMK.
- **1997:** Congress Party withdraws support to the 10-month old H. D. Deve Gowda Government at the center, and stakes its claim to form an alternative government.
- **1999:** Services regained team title in the national boxing championship.
- 2003: Pakistan's Kahuta nuclear plant was banned for 2 years
- 2017: Regal Cinema Hall, one of the famous and oldest cinema halls of Delhi, which was running since 1932, was closed in 2017.
