Strategic importance of Sittwe Port:

- → Sittwe Port, located in Myanmar's Rakhine State, is an important component of the Kaladan Multi-Modal Transit Transport Project, which aims to connect the eastern Indian port of Kolkata with Sittwe Port in Myanmar via sea.
- → This will also reduce dependence on the Siliguri Corridor, known as the Chicken Neck, which lies between Bhutan and Bangladesh.
