Important events of May 12

- International Nurses Day (birthday of Florence Nightingale, the father of modern nursing)
- •1459: Rao Jodha founded Jodhpur.
- •1638: Emperor Shah Jahan commissioned construction of the Red Fort on this day when he decided to shift his capital to Delhi.
- •1666: Under the treaty of Purandar, Shivaji Maharaj reached Agra to meet Aurangzeb.
- •1689: England and Holland formed the League of Augsburg.
- •1797: Napoleon I conquered Venice.
- •1890: Inauguration of the first official cricket county championship match in Bristol.
- •1925: Uzbekistan and Kyrgyzstan became autonomous Soviet republics.
- •1941: Konrad Zuse in Berlin introduced the world's first fully automated Z3 computer.
- •1942: 1500 Jews were killed in gas chambers in Auschwitz.
- •1952: The first session of the Parliament of the Republic of India began.
- •1965: Israel and West Germany exchanged letters to begin diplomatic relations.
- •1987: India brought the HMS Hermes warship from the British Royal Navy and launched it as INS Virat.
- •1998: Central Government decided to increase the retirement age of Central Government employees from 58 years to 60 years.
- •1999: Russia's Deputy Prime Minister Sergei Stepanish was appointed acting Prime Minister, US Finance Minister Robert Rubin resigned from his post.
- 2002: Egypt, Syria and Saudi Arabia expressed their desire for a peace agreement in West Asia.
- •2003: 26 people died in an Al Qaeda attack in the Saudi city of Riyadh.
- **2008:** A magnitude 8.0 earthquake shook China, killing at least 69,000 people.
- •2010: S. H. Kapadia became the 38th Chief Justice of India.
