Important events of May 14

- •1610: In France, Henry IV was assassinated and Louis XIII ascended the throne of France.
- •1657: Dharmavir Chhatrapati Sambhaji Maharaj was born on Purandar fort.
- •1702: The Netherlands and England declared war on Spain and France.
- •1796: James Philip, an eight-year-old boy from Berkeley, Gloucester, England, vaccinated against the world's first goddess.
- •1811: Paraguay became free from Spanish rule.
- •1879: Thomas Edison joined the Edison Telephone Company of Europe.
- •1907: Muhammad Ayub Khan, Pakistani president, was born.
- •1908: In the year 1908, for the first time a person flew in an airplane.
- •1914: Ekanath Dattatreya Kulkarni, educationist and writer, was born at Bhilai, Tal Pandharpur.
- •1923: Narayan Ganesh Chandavarkar, one of the founding members of Indian Congress and social reformer, passed away.
- •1940: WWII Holland surrendered to Germany.
- •**1941:** 36,000 Persian Jews were arrested.
- •1944: British troops captured Kohima.
- •1948: Israel declared independence from Britain.
- •1953: Y. N. Sukthankar was appointed as the Cabinet Secretary of India. He held this office till 31-07-1957.
- •1954: President issues an order extending application of Indian Constitution to Kashmir with the concurrence of the State government.
- •1955: A 20-year Warsaw Pact was signed in Warsaw, Poland by the communist nations of Soviet Russia, Albania, Bulgaria, Czechoslovakia, Hungary, Poland, Romania, and East Germany.
- •1956: Govt announces that decimal coinage will be introduced in India from April 1, 1957.
- •1960: The first plane of India flew up to New York.
- •1963: Dr. Raghuvir, a famous linguist and President of Jan Sangh, passed away.
- •1963: *Kuwait joined the United Nations.*
- •1963: *Kuwait became the 111th member of the United Nations.*

- •1972: Fighting between Indian and Pakistani forces along the Kashmir border reported.
- •1973: The US Supreme Court approved equal rights for women in the military.
- •1976: Pakistan and India agree to resume diplomatic ties.
- •1978: Jagdishchandra Mathur, modern Hindi playwright, passed away.
- •1981: NASA launched space vehicle S-192.
- •1982: All India Radio renamed as 'Akashvani' but its Urdu service still announces that it's All India Radio.
- •1992: LTTE banned in India.
- •1993: Bombay High Court upholds Goa C.M. Ravi Naik's disqualification by speaker under anti-defection bill.
- •1993: Justice V. Ramaswamy decides to resign.
- •1994: LTTE banned for the second time under the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967.
- •1994: RBI announces tight monetary policy.
- •1995: Major train accident near Salem when KK Express collides with goods train killing 51 people.
- •1996: H.D. Deve Gowda was elected leader of the third front as its prime ministerial candidate.
- •1998: India will not sign CTBT unconditionally, says the Prime Minister.
- •1999: Gurucharan Singh Tohra is expelled from Shiromani Akali Dal.
- •1999: The last World Cup of the century started at Lord's (England).
- **2000:** L. K. Advani, Union Home Minister, announces extension of the ban on the LTTE by two more years.
- 2001: Seven agreements between India and Malaysia.
- 2006: New York Times managing editor and Pulitzer Prize winner A.M. Rosenthal died.
- 2007: *Japan approved a bill to amend its pacifist constitution.*
- 2008: Times NIE won the International Newspaper Marketing Association (INMA) Award.
- •2010: India-Russia signed 22 agreements in 2010 in defense, nuclear energy, space, science and technology, hydrocarbons, trade and investment etc.
- •2012: 1,500 Palestinian prisoners in Israeli jails agreed to end the hunger strike.
- •2012: Agni Air Flight CHT crashed in Nepal after a failed go-around, killing 15 people.
- •2013: *Brazil became the 15th country to legalise gay marriage.*
