Important events of May 22

- World Biodiversity Day
- •1420: Jews were expelled from Austria and Syria.
- •1762: Treaty of Hamburg signed between Sweden and Prussia.
- •1859: Scottish author and physicist Sir Arthur Conan Doyle was born on this day.
- •1906: The Wright brothers patented a flying machine.
- •1915: During the First World War, Italy declared war on Austria, Hungary and Germany.
- •1927: A magnitude 8.3 earthquake near Xinjiang, China, killed 200,000 people.
- •1947: The Truman Document was signed in 1947, providing US \$400 million to aid Turkey and Greece in the Cold War.
- •1949: West Germany formally came into existence after the adoption of the constitution.
- •1960: Great Chilean earthquake, the strongest in the world with a magnitude of 9.5.
- •1961: The Dowry Prohibition Act was enacted with the consent of the President.
- •1971: US President Richard Nixon arrived in Moscow, the capital of the Soviet Union, on a week-long visit.
- •1972: Resignation of Pakistan from Commonwealth membership.
- •1972: Ceylon adopted a new constitution and became a republic. The country was renamed Sri Lanka and entered the Commonwealth.
- •1977: Benin adopted the constitution.
- •1984: Bachendri Pal became the first Indian woman to conquer the world's highest peak, Everest.
- •1987: Hashimpura massacre in Meerut, Uttar Pradesh, India.
- •1990: The Republic of Yemen emerged in 1990 with the merger of North and South Yemen.
- •1992: Bosnia, Slovenia and Croatia became members of the UN.
- **1996:** Michel Camdessus was elected Managing Director of the International Monetary Fund for the third time for the next five years.
- **2001:** *The Dalai Lama gave up the demand for independence of Tibet.*
- •2002: Parliament dissolved in Nepal.

- •2003: More than thousands of people were killed in the devastating earthquake that struck Algeria.
- 2004: *Dr. Manmohan Singh became the 13th Prime Minister of India.*
- •2007: Mathematician Srinivasa Vardhan was awarded Norway's Abel Prize.
- 2008: Pakistan was included in the 47-member Human Rights Committee of the United Nations.

- •1772: Raja Ram Mohan Roy, an Indian historian and one of the founders of the Brahmo Sabha.
- •1783: William Sturgeon, an English physicist, and inventor.
- •1813: Richard Wagner, a German composer, theater director, polemicist, and conductor.
- •1859: Sir Arthur Conan Doyle, a British writer, and medical doctor. He created the character, Sherlock Holmes.
- •1871: Vishnu Vaman Bapat, an Indian philosopher.
- •1878: The Great Gama was an Indian wrestler who remained the undefeated champion of the world.
- •1900: Devdas Mohandas Gandhi, the fourth and youngest son of Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi.
