### **Important events of May 23**

- •1785: Benjamin Franklin wrote in a letter that his invention was bilingual.
- •1788: South Carolina was admitted into the U.S. Constitution as the eighth state.
- •1805: Governor-General Lord Wellesley, through an order, made a permanent provision for the Mughal Emperor of Delhi.
- •1829: Cyrill Damien patented the accordion.
- •1879: Iowa State University established the first veterinary school in the US.
- **1901:** *American forces captured Filipino rebel leader Emilio Aguinaldo.*
- •1915: During the First World War, Italy declared war on Austria, Hungary and Germany.
- •1923: Belgium created Savana Airlines.
- •1926: French forces captured the Moroccan Rifles capital.
- •1939: A plan to liberate Palestine by 1949 was made in the British Parliament.
- •1949: West Germany formally came into existence after the adoption of the constitution.
- •1951: Tibet signed a 17-point agreement with China for the peaceful liberation of Tibet.
- •1956: A bill to nationalize the life insurance business was passed.
- **1960:** *Israel announced the capture of Nazi Adolf Eichmann in Argentina.*
- •1977: Benin adopted a constitution.
- •1984: Bachendri Pal became the first Indian woman to conquer the world's highest peak, Everest.
- •1986: The United States and Western European countries vetoed a proposal for heavy sanctions against South Africa.
- •1994: 270 pilgrims died in a stampede in Saudi Arabia.
- •1994: Roman Herzog was elected President of Germany.
- •1995: The first edition of the Java programming language was released.
- •1999: Johannes Rau was appointed the new President of the Federal Republic of Germany.
- •2001: Pakistan again refused to grant MFN status to India.
- •2004: 250 people drowned when a boat sank in the Meghna river due to a storm in Bangladesh. 4000 cars sank when a ship collided with a tanker in Singapore.

- •2010: Thailand's film 'Uncle Boonmee Who Can Recall His Past Lives' directed by Apichatpong Weerasethakul was awarded the biggest award 'Palme d'Or' at the Cannes Film Festival.
- •2010: A three-member bench of the Supreme Court of India headed by Chief Justice K.G.
