### Important events of May 9

- •1338: Sant Chokhoba passed away.
- •1386: One of the oldest treaties in the world, the Windsor Treaty, was signed between Portugal and England.
- •1576: The Battle of Haldighati started between Maharana Pratap and Akbar.
- •1588: The troops of Duke Henry de Guise captured Paris.
- •1653: The world famous historical building Taj Mahal was constructed after 22 years of continuous hard work.
- •1689: British ruler William III declared war on France.
- •1753: Maharaja Surajmal attack on Delhi.
- •1812: The War began between America and Britain.
- •1815: Napoleon was stripped of power in France after his defeat by Britain at Waterloo.
- •1866: Gopal Krishna Gokhale, freedom fighter and political leader, was born in Kotluk village of Ratnagiri district of Maharashtra.
- •1874: First horse-drawn tram car started running in Mumbai.
- •1877: A magnitude 8.8 earthquake off the coast of Peru killed 2,541 people.
- •1904: Steam-powered City Truro becomes the first engine in Europe to reach speeds of over 160 km/h.
- •1907: Two thousand dacoits riot in eastern Bengal.
- •1908: Arkalgudun Krishnarao, Kannada writer, was born.
- •1917: Fighting breaks out at Kharkwasta in the north-west frontier of India.
- •1919: Ram Kumar Gupta, great industrialist, was born at Delhi.
- •1933: Gandhiji announced suspension of Civil Disobedience Movement for six weeks and called on the Government to withdraw its Ordinances.
- •1946: The first Satyagraha movement was started against the Portuguese rule in Goa under the leadership of Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia.
- •1947: The World Bank gave its first loan to France.
- •1955: West Germany became a part of NATO.

- •1959: Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil, founder of Rayat Educational Institute, passed away.
- •1960: America became the first country to legalize birth control pills.
- •1975: The first electric typing machine was made.
- •1979: An arms control agreement was signed between the United States and the Soviet Union.
- •1981: Durga Bai Deshmukh died at Hyderabad. She was a social reformer, freedom fighter, planner, administrator, educationist and parliamentarian. She worked for peace, social welfare and for the betterment of the downtrodden.
- •1992: Killer brew claims 175 lives in Orissa, Excise Minister Prasanna Kumar Acharya resigns.
- •1992: Madhu Sapre, Miss India, is crowned the second runner-up at the Miss Universe beauty pageant.
- •1992: M. J. Pherwani, National Housing Bank Chairman, resigns following his bank's involvement in the Security scandal.
- •1993: S. Mulgaokar, 82, journalist, passed away.
- •1993: Three hundred people died in a landslide in the Nambija region of the South American country Ecuador.
- •1995: Militants set Charar township on fire in the vicinity of the Charar-e-Sharif shrine. More than 1,000 houses burnt.
- •1995: Two new gas and oil reserves found off the Gujarat and Bombay coast.
- •1995: Abha Gandhi, servant to Mahatma Gandhi, passed away. He was 68 years.
- •1996: LDF wins 80 seats and UDF 59 in Kerala elections .
- •1996: Kerala CM A.K. Antony resigns.
- •1996: J. Jayalalitha, Tamil Nadu CM, resigns.
- •1997: Hareesh Khandelwal, an accused in the fodder scam, commits suicide by jumping before a train at Dhanbad in Bihar.
- •1997: At least 71 persons were killed and nine injured when a truck carrying a marriage party plunges into a gorge near Gasota in Hamirpur district of Himachal Pradesh.
- •1998: Kirit Raval is appointed Solicitor-General of India.
- •1998: Playback singer Talat Mehmood, 75, passed away in Mumbai.
- •1999: India's Rupi Unnikrishnan won silver in the prone group at the Atlanta Grand Prix shooting event.
- 2002: Indications of involvement of a Pakistani organization in the Karachi blast.
- •2003: Google introduced the Internet program AdSense.
- •2006: The European Constitution was approved in the European country Estonia.
- 2009: NASA sent a reconnaissance spacecraft to the Moon to search for water.
- •2012: US President Barack Obama gave his support to gay marriage.
