#### Important events of June 1

- World Milk Day
- •1670: King Charles II of England and King Louis 14 of France signed a secret anti-Dutch treaty.
- •1746: French forces captured Antwerp.
- •1786: Madras General Post Office started functioning.
- •1790: A treaty was signed between Marathas, Britishers and Nizam.
- •1819: William Carey, Ward and Marshman established the Serampore College in Bengal.
- •1831: James Clark Ross became the first European at the North Magnetic Pole.
- •1842: Satyendranath Tagore, Bengali officer and litterateur, was born.
- •1874: East India Company was finally dissolved.
- •1880: The first pay-phone service was started.
- •1890: Sri Seeripi Anjaneyulu, journalist, social reformer and educationist, was born at Dharmavaram, Anantapur.
- •1904: Four Language panels were used for Rangoon. This panel had languages namely Burmese, Urdu, Tamil and Chinese.
- •1916: Lokmanya Tilak roared "Freedom is by birthright" at Ahmednagar.
- •1916: German forces attacked Fort Vaux in Verdun.
- •1922: The Royal Ulster Police was officially established.
- •1927: Justice Savyasachi Mukherjee was born.
- •1927: Peaceful relations were restored between the United States and Canada.
- •1929: V. Shantaram, S. Fattehlal (Sheikh Syed Fattehlal), Vishnupant Damle and Keshavrao B. Dhaiber, alongwith Sita Ram Kulkami, founded the 'Prabhat Film Company' at Kolhapur.
- •1930: First Indian luxurious fast train 'Deccan Queen' started from Victoria Terminus (CST) to Pune.
- •1930: Baba Adhav was born.
- •1933: Fortnightly 'Bal Sanmitra' was published.
- •1835: Teaching started in Calcutta Medical College from 1835.
- •1938: Continental Publication' started.
- •1941: British forces captured Iraq's capital Baghdad.
- •1944: M. V. Dhurandhar, famous master painter of Maharashtra, passed away.
- •1944: Liladhar Jagudi, well known Hindi poet, passed away.
- •1945: Tata Fundamental Research Institute was established.
- •1947: Balbhimraj Gore, litterateur and Hindi critic, was born.
- •1948: Israel and Arab countries agreed on a ceasefire.
- •1955: India's Untouchability (Offense) Act comes into force.

- •1959: The Chinese occupy Tibet and Dalai Lama flees to India.
- •1959: National Aeronautical Research Laboratory (NARL) set up under CSIR with temporary offices in New Delhi. Dr. P. Nilakantan is appointed NARL's first Director.
- •1959: N.G. Ranga resigned from the Indian National Congress and took up the leadership of the newly formed the Swatantra Party.
- •1964: Nava Paisa, established in 1947, was renamed as 'Paisa'.
- •1964: Rashid Ghulam Muhammad Patel, cricketer (Indian pace bowler, better known for Lamba incident), was born in Sabarkantha.
- •1965: About 250 people died in a coal mine explosion in Fukuoka region of Japan.
- •1969: In Canada, tobacco products and their related advertisements on radio and TV were completely banned.
- •1970: An egg was thrown at British Prime Minister Harold Wilson outside an election meeting.
- •1970: Monopolies and Restrictive Trade Practices Act was enforced. This act was passed in 1969.
- •1972: Space Commission and Department of Space was set up. Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) brought under the Department of Space (DOS).
- •1979: On this day, the rule of minority white people ended after 90 years in Rhodesia and it was announced that the country would now be known as Zimbabwe in 1979.
- •1980: AIADMK wins Tamil Nadu Assembly election; Congress (I) wins in U.P, M.P, Gujarat, Rajasthan, Punjab, Maharashtra and Orissa.
- •1980: Cable News Network (CNN) television network started broadcasting for the first time.
- •1984: Operation Blue Star to remove Jarnail Singh Bhindranwale and his followers began with CRPF and BSF firing at the Guru Ram Das Langar building in the vicinity of Golden Temple.
- •1992: Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Academy established at Satara.
- •1992: S.K. Datta became the director of the Central Bureau of Investigation (till 31/07/93).
- •1992: An air agreement was signed between India and Israel.
- •1993: Guatemala's President Jorge Serrano was ousted from power by the army.
- •1993: Burkina Faso President Blaise Campaore visits India.
- •1993: Premkumar Sharma, MLA of Bharatiya Janata Party, was assassinated.
- •1993: Speaker disqualifies four Ajit group MPs.
- •1995: Kanshi Ram (Bahujan Samaj Party) withdraws support to the Mulayam Singh Yadav-led government in UP and stakes claim to form a new government.
- •1996: H.D. Deve Gowda's 21-member Central cabinet sworn in.
- •1996: Neelam Sanjiva Reddy, former President of India, passed away.
- •1997: New postal rates effective; postcard-25 p, inland letter-Re.1, envelope-Rs.2 and Registration-Rs.10.
- •1997: Ghulam Rasool Wani, National Conference leader, kidnapped and shot dead by militants at Kaskot in Doda district, Jammu.
- •1997: Union Minister for Forests and Environment, Prof. Saifuddin Soz announces Rs. 9 crore central package for afforestation and eco-development in J&K.
- •1998: Finance Minister announced the Swadeshi budget.
- •1998: Petrol price is raised by Re.1 per liter.
- •1998: The Prasar Bharati Bill is introduced in the Lok Sabha to revive the Prasar Bharati Act, 1990.
- •2001: The infamous Nepalese royal massacre happened inside Narayanhity Royal Palace. This tragic incident left nine members of the royal family dead including King Birendra and Queen Aishwarya.
- •2004:: Ramesh Chandra Lahoti took over as the 35th Chief Justice of India.
- •2005: Appa Sherpa successfully climbed Mount Everest for the 15th time.
- •2007: Smoking in public places was completely banned in Britain from 2007.
- •2008: The International Anti-Terrorism Conference was held in New Delhi.
- •2008: US presidential candidate Barack Obama resigned from the membership of Trinity United Church of Chicago in 2008.

- •2010: In Central America, 150 people died in Guatemala in 2010 due to tropical storm Agatha which came from the Pacific Ocean.
- •2014: In Nigeria, 40 people lost their lives in a blast in a football field.
