Important events of June 10

- •1190: The Roman Emperor Frederick Barbarossa died during the Third Crusade.
- •1246: Nasiruddin Muhammad Shah became the first ruler of Delhi.
- •1624: An anti-Spanish treaty was signed between Holland and France.
- •1786: Due to an earthquake in Sichuan province of China, the dam on the Dadu River broke, killing one lakh people.
- •1829: The first boat race between Oxford and Cambridge Universities of Britain took place.
- •1832: Edwin Arnold, English writer (Light of India), was born.
- •1833: Azad Muhammad Jussain, Urdu poet and educationalist, was born.
- •1848: The first telegraph line between New York and Chicago began.
- •1854: The very first batch of students of the United States Naval Academy graduated.
- •1888: Balraj Bhalla, revolutionary, was born.
- •1890: Sunday introduced as a weekly holiday.
- •1891: Gandhiji called to the Bar.
- •1900: Jayantnath Chaudhary, former General of Indian Army General, was born.
- •1907: An agreement was signed between France and Japan to maintain the independence and integrity of China.
- •1908: Mary Clubwala Jadhav, politician and social worker, was born.
- •1924: Assassination of Italian socialist leader Giacomo Matteotti.
- •1924: Fascists kidnapped and murdered Italian socialist leader Giacomo Matteotti in Rome.
- •1928: Papan Ramchand Panjabi, cricket test umpire for 7 tests from 1978-81, was born in Mumbai.
- •1931: Norway occupied eastern Greenland.
- •1934: Diplomatic relations between the Soviet Union and Romania were reestablished.
- •1940: Norway surrendered to the Nazis.
- •1940: Canada declared war on Italy.
- •1940: World War II Norway surrendered to Germany.
- •1942: 77 Mountain Brigade was raised at Sagar, Madhya Pradesh.
- •1944: World War II Six hundred forty-two men, women, and children massacred at Oradour-Sur-Glane, France.
- •1946: Gandhiji refused to enthuse over allied victory as it was not a "victory of truth over false-hood".
- •1946: After the end of the monarchy, Italy became a republic.
- •1955: Prakash Padukone, internationally famous Badminton player, was born.
- •1957: Bhai Vir Singh, great Punjabi poet, novelist, social reformer, musician, humanitarian and Padma Bhushan awardee, died.
- •1957: The Six Day War ended with a ceasefire agreement between Israel and Syria.

- •1959: Tyagmurti Goswami Ganeshdutt, social worker, died near Haridwar.
- •1960: Production of Russian fighter aircraft MiG started in Nashik.
- •1966: Production of Air Force fighter aircraft 'MiG' started in Nashik district of Maharashtra.
- •1967: Israel accepted the Arab ceasefire proposed in the 1967 war.
- •1971: The US ended its 21-year trade embargo on China.
- •1972:The fully air-conditioned ship Harshvardhan was launched from Mumbai's Madgaon port.
- •1972: Elvis Presley recorded his live album at Madison Square Garden in New York City.
- •1977: One of the first home computers, Apple II was made available in the market for sale.
- •1983: Margaret Thatcher became Prime Minister of Britain again.
- •1984: Top army commander killed in Bihar; Sikh troops desert unit.
- •1986: India won the Test match at Lord's for the first time by defeating England by 5 wickets.
- •1987: Jeevan, famous Hindi film actor, died.
- •1994: China conducted secret nuclear tests in the Lok'nor area.
- •1995: The world's heaviest clock, weighing 5,100 kilograms, was installed in the Vixelles area of Europe.
- •1996: A biological weapons factory was destroyed in Baghdad in 1996.
- •1997: Three Indians Kumaramangalam Birla, Ratan Tata and Dhirubhai Ambani figure in the list of Asia's top 100 super rich.
- •1997: 18 persons were killed and 10 wounded by suspected National Liberation Front of Tripura militants at Thalchhara near Agartala.
- •1999: Ustad Zakir Hussain was selected for the prestigious National Heritage Award in the United States.
- •1999: In Kerala, a private international airport started operating in 1999 at Nedumbassery in Kochi city.
- •1999: Yugoslav forces withdrew from Kosovo.
- •2001: Berlusconi was appointed Prime Minister of Italy.
- •2002: Pakistan changed the name of the world's second highest peak "K-2" to 'Chogori' or 'Shahgoli'.
- •2003: Spirit, one of the two rovers of NASA's Mars Exploration Rover Mission was launched.
- •2008: At the 54th National Film Awards announced, Lage Raho Munnabhai starring Sanjay Dutt in the lead role was selected as the Best Popular Film.
- •2008: George Minolas, president of an industries association in northern Greece, was kidnapped by unidentified persons.
