- World Day Against Child Labour
- Russia Day : Russia
- •1381: In England the peasants revolted.
- •1665: New Amsterdam legally became part of Britain and was renamed New York after the Duke of York.
- •1691: Innocent (XII) became Pope in place of Pope Alexander (VIII).
- •1752: Chanda Sahib in Karnataka surrendered.
- •1787: A law was passed in America setting a minimum age limit of 30 years for Senators.
- •1812: Napoleon Bonaparte attacked Russia.
- •1830: France began the process of colonizing Algeria.
- •1849: Lewis Phectic Haslett received a patent for a gas mask.
- •1889: 88 people died in a train accident in Armagh, Northern Ireland.
- •1898: General Emilio Oguinaldo declared Portugal's independence from Spain.
- •1905: Gopalkrishna Gokhale founded the Servants of Indian Society.
- •1913: John Bray's first American cartoon film 'The Artist's Dream' was released.
- •1926: Brazil decided to leave the League of Nations.
- •1937: In the Soviet Union, 8 army men were killed.
- •1952: The then Soviet Union declared the peace treaty with Japan illegal.
- •1952: Jammu & Kashmir assembly finally terminated hereditary monarchy.
- •1964: Nelson Mandela, the leader who led the movement against apartheid in South Africa, was sentenced to life imprisonment.
- •1975: Allahabad court annulled Indira Gandhi's election and barred her from contesting for six years.
- •1987: Margaret Thatcher's historic victory for the third time in the British elections.
- •1990: The Russian Parliament formally declared Russia's sovereignty.
- •1990: Russian Federation parliament formally declared itself to be sovereign. This day is celebrated as Russia Day.
- •1991: Boris Yeltsin became the President of the then Russian Republic.
- •1994: World's biggest twinjet, Boeing 777, took its first flight.
- •1994: The world's largest twinjet aircraft, the Boeing 777, made its first flight.
- •1998: the G-8 countries decided not to give loans to India and Pakistan due to nuclear testing.
- •1999: Pakistan's defence budget increased by around 11 per cent in 1999, UN Security Council approval for 'mission' to East Timor.
- •2001: India-Bangladesh talks began on the border issue.

- •2002: Argentina was eliminated from the 2002 World Cup after a draw with Sweden.
- •2002: World Day Against Child Labour was started.
- •2004: G8 conference held in Savannah (Georgia).
- •2004: US President Bush rejected the proposal for direct talks with North Korean supreme leader Kim Jong Il.
- •2007: Four Indians selected for Biology Olympiad to be held in Canada.
- •2007: Sikh students were allowed to keep the religious symbol Kirpan in Australian schools.
- •2008: The South Asian Football Confederation was awarded the hosting rights of the 6th SAF Football Championship for the year 2009.
- •2008: Eminent film director Mrinal Sen was awarded at the 10th Osian's Cinefan Film Festival.
- •2016: Saina Nehwal won the Australian Open title for the second time.
