Important events of June 17

- World Day to Combat Desertification and Drought
- •1397: The Kalmar Union between Denmark, Sweden and Norway was established.
- •1429: Dauphin was crowned as the King of France.
- •1549: Jews were expelled from the Ghent region of Belgium.
- •1609: Netherlands, England and France signed a 12-year contract.
- •1631: Mumtaz Mahal, the wife of Mughal emperor Shah Jahan, died while giving birth to the 14th child. Taj Mahal was built in her memory.
- •1712: England, Portugal and France signed a truce.
- •1756: Nawab Siraj-ud-Daula attacked Calcutta (now Kolkata) with 50 thousand soldiers.
- •1775: The British army defeated the Continental Army of America in the Battle of Bunker Hill.
- •1799: Napoleon Bonaparte included Italy in his empire.
- •1858: Rani Lakshmibai of Jhansi, the heroine of the Indian freedom struggle, was martyred.
- •1885: Statue Of Liberty arrived in the New York Harbor on the French ship, named Isere.
- •1898: Navy Hospital Corp was established in America.
- •1917: Mahatma Gandhi made his residence in the heart of Sabarmati Ashram.
- •1917: George V changed the family's surname to Windsor. Earlier this royal The family was known as the German royal house 'Saxe Coburg and Gotha'.
- •1929: The Soviet Union ended diplomatic relations with China.
- •1938: Japan declared war on China.
- •1944: Iceland was declared independent and became a republic.
- •1944: Germany surrendered in World War II.
- •1950: Egypt, Lebanon, Syria and Saudi Arabia signed a security treaty.
- •1961: India's first jet aircraft, HAL HF-24 Marut took its first flight. It was a fighter-bomber aircraft.
- •1963: The US Supreme Court banned compulsory reading of the Bible in schools.
- •1967: Nuclear weapons testing: China announced a successful test of its first thermonuclear weapon.
- •1970: The first kidney transplant operation took place in Chicago.
- •1974: 11 people were injured in a bomb blast in the British Parliament.
- •1974: 41 people were injured in a bomb blast in the London Tower.
- •1981: 14 people were killed in a conflict between Muslims and Christians in Cairo, Egypt.
- •1987: The last of the Dusky Seaside Sparrow died and became extinct.
- •1994: The FIFA World Cup of Football started in Chicago.
- •1994: North Korea agreed to allow the International Atomic Energy Agency to stay in its country.
- •1999: In the World Cup semi-final, the match between Australia and South Africa was tied. Australia reached the final due to better run rate in the group stage.

- •1999: Lekaev Juma appointed Vice President of South Africa, in view of the ongoing war in Kargil, Kargil Jihad Fund was established by ISI.
- •2002: The American Consulate was reopened in Karachi.
- •2003: 165 Iranian terrorists arrested in France.
- •2004: Stones similar to Earth's rocks were found on Mars.
- •2008: The indigenously developed light combat aircraft 'Tejas' was successfully tested in Bangalore.
- •2012: Saina Nehwal became Indonesia Open champion for the third time.
- •2012: For the first time in the history of Egypt, general elections for the post of President were held.
- •2012: China's "Shenzhou-9" spacecraft was successful in reaching the designated orbit after being launched.
- •2012: In an article published on its English website 'Voice of Jihad', the Taliban praises India and said that Afghanistan's soil will not be allowed to be used against it.
- •2015: A gunman killed nine people in a church in South Carolina, USA.
