Important events of June 18

- •1576: The Battle of Haldighati started between Maharana Pratap and the ruler of the Mughal Empire, Akbar.
- •1658: Aurangzeb captured the Agra Fort.
- •1812: The War began between America and Britain.
- •1815: Napoleon was removed from power in France after his defeat by Britain at Waterloo.
- •1817: Waterloo Bridge, built on the River Thames in London, was opened.
- •1837: Spain adopted a new constitution.
- •1923: In Italy, sixty thousand people became homeless due to the reawakening of Mount Etna.
- •1940: The Forward Bloc of the Indian National Congress was founded in 1940 by Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose.
- •1941: Turkey signed a peace treaty with Nazi Germany.
- •1946: The first Satyagraha movement against Portuguese rule in Goa was started under the leadership of Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia.
- •1956: Hindu Succession Act was passed.
- •1972: A British European Airways plane crashed in an open field and 118 people were killed in this accident.
- •1979: The SALT-II agreement was signed in Vienna by US President Jimmy Carter and Soviet President Brezhnev.
- •1980: Shakuntala Devi multiplied two 13-digit numbers and gave the correct answer in 28 seconds.
- •1987: M.S. Swaminathan received the first World Food Prize.
- •1991: Despite not having an absolute majority, Congress became the largest party in the Lok Sabha.
- •1993: BJP at its 14th National Council in Bengaluru took oath on Hindutva on this day.
- •1997: Prakash Padukone started the Indian Badminton Federation (IBC).
- •1999: *Drinking water agreement signed between 35 European countries in London.*
- •1999: In Latvia, Vaike Friberema was elected as the new President of the country.
- •2001: The Taliban repealed bin Laden's fatwa against the United States.
- •2003: Google launched the internet program AdSense.
- •2004: Chadian troops killed 69 Sudanese militiamen on 18 June 2004.
- •2008: The Government of India announced to give 5% reservation to Gurjars in OBC quota.
- •2008: Three agreements were signed in 2008 between Syrian President Bashar al-Assad, who was on a visit to India, and Prime Minister Dr. Manmohan Singh.
- •2008: Pharma company Ranbaxy settled the patent dispute with American pharmaceutical company Pfizer under an agreement.
- •2008: Vietnam lifted restrictions on rice exports in 2008 to improve supply conditions in the world market.

- •2009: NASA sent a reconnaissance spacecraft to search for water on the Moon.
- •2013: 31 people were killed and 60 were injured in two suicide attacks in Iraq's capital Baghdad.
- •2013: 27 people died in a suicide attack in Shergarh, Pakistan.
- •2017: Pakistan defeated India and won the ICC Champions Trophy.

- •1817: Jung Bahadur, the first Rana Prime Minister of Nepal and founder of the Rana dynasty, was born.
- •1852: Famous national leader C. Vijaya Raghava Chariar was born in Salem district of Tamil Nadu.
- •1887: Anugrah Narayan Sinha, Indian freedom fighter, teacher, lawyer, politician and creator of modern Bihar, was born.
- •1899: Freedom fighter, Gandhian thinker and famous writer Dada Dharmadhikari was born in 1899 in Betul district of Madhya Pradesh.
- •1922: French pianist Claude Helfer was born.
- •1931: K.S. Sudarshan, the fifth Sarsanghchalak of Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh, was born in 1931 in Raipur district of Chhattisgarh.
