Important events of June 2

- Telangana Day (Telangana, India)
- •1746: Russia and Austria signed several agreements.
- •1756: Fort William, the English stronghold in Bengal, was surrendered to Siraj-ud-Daulah.
- •1780: Anti-Catholic protesters attacked the Parliament in London.
- •1851: For the first time in America, the prohibition law was implemented in the state of Maine.
- •1897: Guglielmo Marconi applied for a patent for radio in his name in 1896, which was later accepted on July 2, 1897.
- •1908: Sri Aurobindo, a freedom fighter, was arrested in the ManikTala Bomb explosion case.
- •1909: Alfred Deakin was elected Prime Minister of Australia for the third consecutive time.
- •1946: Italy overthrew King Umberto II and declared itself a republic.
- •1947: Lord Louis Mountbatten announced the partition of India.
- •1953: Queen Elizabeth II was crowned on the British throne.
- •1966: America landed a spacecraft on the moon in its first attempt.
- •1974: Mali adopted its constitution.
- •1975: *India's First Sponge Iron project inaugurated at Vijayawada.*
- •1979: Pope John Paul II started his first official visit to his native Poland, became the first Pope to visit a Communist country.
- •1966: Ukraine became a nuclear free country after handing over its last nuclear weapon to Russia.
- •1999: High level talks were agreed upon between South and North Korea. TV broadcasting started in Bhutan.
- •2003: All educational institutions of the country were closed after the arrest of Myanmar's democratic leader Aung San Suu Kyi.
- •2004: Australian model Jennifer Hawkins became Miss Universe.
- •2005: The Vladivostok conference of India, Russia and China ended.
- •2006: America imposed sanctions on Dawood Ibrahim and his organization.
- •2011: More than 20 people died and more than 1600 people fell ill in Europe in 2011 due to E-coli bacteria infection.
- •2011: The Indian government approved the first phase of the Rajiv Gandhi Awas Yojana to help the poor get rid of slums in urban areas and fulfill their dream of owning a house.
- •2014: On this day in 2014, Telangana became the 29th state of India.
