- •1555: Emperor Humayun declared his son Akbar as his heir.
- •1593: In the Battle of Sisak, the collective army of Christians defeated the Ottoman Turks.
- •1633: Pope forced Galileo Galilei to take back his view that the Sun is the center of the universe and not earth.
- •1844: The Delta Kappa Epsilon Society at Yale University was founded.
- •1870: The US Congress established the United States Department of Justice.
- •1897: In Pune, the Chapekar brothers shot dead the then District Magistrate Walter Charles Rand.
- •1906: Sweden adopted the national flag.
- •1908: Ascension of King George V of England.
- •**1911:** George V was crowned in 1911.
- •1939: Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose separated from Congress and founded the Forward Block.
- •1940: Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose quitted the Congress and formed the All India Forward Bloc.
