Important events of June 25

- •529: Mughal ruler Babur conquered Bengal and returned to his capital Agra.
- •1206: Qutb-ud-din Aibak became the Sultan of Delhi.
- •1788: Virginia became the 10th state to ratify the US Constitution.
- •1868: US President Andrew Johnson passed a law for government employees to work eight hours a day.
- •1913: Ghadar Party was formed under the chairmanship of Baba Sohan Singh.
- •1932: The Indian cricket team played its first Test match at Lord's ground in Britain.
- •1940: German dictator Adolf Hitler visits Napoleon's tomb and the Eiffel Tower in Paris, France.
- •1941: Finland declared war on the Soviet Union.
- •1947: Anne Frank's Diary of a Young Girl was published on this day. It sold 30 million copies and was translated into 67 languages.
- •1950: The Korean Civil War began. This civil war, which began between North and South Korea fighting for independence, later took the form of an international cold war.
- •1951: American television and radio network CBS broadcast the first color TV programmes from New York to four cities.
- •1960: Madagascar became independent from France.
- •1961: Iraq declared that Kuwait was part of Iraq.
- •1975: On the advice of the Congress government led by Indira Gandhi, the President of India, Fakhruddin Ali Ahmed, declared emergency in the country.
- •1977: The anniversary of the Emergency, 25 June 1977, is celebrated as 'Black Day'.
- •1983: India won the Cricket World Cup title for the first time by defeating West Indies by 43 runs.
- •1993: Kim Campbell became the 19th Prime Minister of Canada.
- •1994: Japanese Prime Minister Sutomu Hata resigned from his post.
- •1998: United States President Bill Clinton arrived in China on a 9 day visit.
- •1999: the United States announced a reward of \$5 million for information leading to the arrest of Yugoslav President Slobodan Milosevic.
- •2002: The new cabinet in Afghanistan was sworn in.
- •2004: Russia decided to increase strategic partnership with India.
- •2005: Ahmadinejad became the President of Iran.
- •2005: The victory of Mahmoud Ahmadinejad, considered to be an extremely radical, in the presidential elections of Iran was also announced.
- •2008: the Uttar Pradesh government made the registration of houses and plots cheaper by reducing the stamp duty on it from 8% to 5%.
- •2014: Luis Suarez was accused of biting an opposition player during the 2014 FIFA World Cup.
- •2017: Srikanth won the Australia Open Super Series title in 2017.
