Important events of June 26

- International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking & International Day in Support of Victims of Torture
- •1498: The first toothbrush was made in China in 1498. The first model of the modern toothbrush was patented by a Chinese king.
- •1714: Spain and the Netherlands signed a trade and peace agreement.
- •1888: Narayan Shripad Rajhans (Balgandharv), famous singer and actor, was born.
- •1888: Ghanshyam Das Birla, great freedom fighter and social reformer, was born at Pilani.
- •1894: Carl Benz of Germany obtained a US patent for a gas-powered auto.
- •1906: M.P. Sivagnanam, famous Tamil writer and social worker, was born at Madras.
- •1906: The first Grand Prix was held. The competition lasted for 12 hours.
- •1906: First ever Grand Prix motor race was held at the Le Mans circuit of France.
- •1909: The Victoria and Albert Museum opened in London.
- •1919: Publication of New York Daily News began in America.
- •1927: Dialogue cinema began its life. Since the beginning of film production, there has been a constant effort to make films that also have dialogues.
- •1941: During World War II, Finland opened a front against Russia.
- •1945: 50 countries signed the United Nations Charter in San Francisco.
- •1949: Women got the right to vote for the first time in the Belgian parliamentary elections.
- •1952: Nelson Mandela and 51 others violated curfew in South Africa.
- •1954: Nehru, Chou En-lai pledge good-neighbor policy at New Delhi.
- •1955: Poland and India affirm Panchsheel.
- •1960: The French colony of Madagascar gained independence. Every year this day is celebrated as National Day in this country.
- •1963: US President John F. Kennedy addressed a huge crowd in the West German city of Berlin. He described Berlin as a major strategic hub during the Cold War.
- •1974: Rajarshi Shahu Chhatrapati, great revolutionary freedom fighter and social reformer, was born.
- •1975: Chaudhary Charan Singh, freedom fighter and Chief Minister of UP, arrested by Government.
- •1977: *Elvis Presley performed the last concert of his life in Indiana, USA.*
- •1979: Boxer Muhammad Ali retired.
- •1982: First Boeing 707 of Air India `Gaurishankar' crashed at Sahar Airport (Bombay).
- •1983: Five hundred killed or missing as monsoon floods hit the Indian state of Gujarat.
- •1991: Sharad Pawar joins the Union Cabinet as Defence Minister.

- •1992: The Tin Bigha corridor leased to Bangladesh as per the Indo-Bangladesh agreement.
- •1994: PLO leader Yasser Arafat returned to Gaza after 27 years.
- •1995: Madhya Pradesh declared "Tiger State" as it houses one sixth of the world's tiger population.
- •1997: India declares its chemical weapon stockpiles and storage facilities as part of its obligations as signatory to the Chemical Weapons Convention.
- •1997: The first book of the Harry Potter series, Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone, was first published.
- •1999: The World Science Conference started in Budapest (Hungary).
- •2000: P Bandopadhyay became the first woman Air Commodore in the Air Force.
- •2000: Bangladesh was granted Test status by the International Cricket Council.
- •2004: After the resignation of Pakistan Prime Minister Jamali, Shujaat Hussain became the new acting Prime Minister.
- •2008: Multinational company Riorito acquired a mineral lease for diamond mining in Chhatarpur district in Bundelkhand region of Madhya Pradesh.
- •2013: 20 people were killed when a rescue helicopter crashed in Uttarakhand.
