- •1818: Maratha wars between British & Maratha Confederacy in India ended.
- •1915: Rabindranath Tagore was conferred the prestigious Knighthood by the British Government.
- •1918: A 'Hindi Sahitya Sammelan' was organized in Indore under the chairmanship of Gandhiji and Hindi was considered the official language by a resolution passed in it.
- •1938: Germany passed a law related to Entartete Art making art robbery legal.
- •1943: The United Nations established the Relief and Rehabilitation Administration.
- •1947: Lord Mountbatten released the 3 June Plan or Mountbatten Plan on the partition of India. As per this plan, The Independence Act of 1947 was implemented.
