### Important events of June 5

- *World Environment Day*
- **1882:** Nearly one lakh people died due to storms and floods in Bombay (now Mumbai).
- **1915:** The constitution of Denmark was amended and women were given voting rights.
- **1937:** Henry Ford introduced the 32 hours working a week concept.
- **1959:** Formation of Singapore's first government.
- **1968:** US presidential candidate Robert F. Kennedy was assassinated, and Kennedy died the next day.
- **1507:** England and the Netherlands agreed on a trade agreement.
- **1659:** Aurangzeb, the ruler of the Mughal Empire, officially ascended the throne of Delhi.
- **1661:** Great scientist Isaac Newton took admission in Trinity College, Cambridge.
- **1664:** Mustafa II became the Sultan of Turkey.
- **1752:** Benjamin Franklin flew a kite for the first time in 1752 to show that electricity is a source of electricity.
- **1827:** During the Greek war of independence, the Turks captured the Acropolis and Athens.
- **1846:** In America, the telegraph line between Philadelphia and Baltimore was started.
- **1875:** The Pacific Stock Exchange was started in San Francisco, America.
- **1882:** About one lakh people died in Bombay (now Mumbai) in 1882 due to storm and flood.
- **1912:** The US Navy attacked Cuba for the third time.
- **1915:** Denmark amended its constitution and gave women the right to vote.
- **1924:** Ernest Alexanderson sent the first fax across the Atlantic Ocean.
- **1942:** America declared war on Bulgaria, Hungary and Romania.
- **1953:** Denmark adopted a new constitution.
- **1967:** Israel attacked Egypt in 1967 and destroyed about four hundred of its fighter planes.
- **1968:** Famous American MP Robert Kennedy was attacked in a hotel in Los Angeles, USA.
- **1972:** World Environment Day started in 1972 with the World Environment Conference organized by the United Nations General Assembly.
- **1977:** Apple introduced the Apple II computer.
- **1984:** Under Operation Blue Star, the Indian Army entered the Golden Temple of Amritsar, Punjab, the religious place of the Sikhs, in 1984.
- **1990:** The last President of the Soviet Union, Mikhail Gorbachev, was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize.
- **2001:** The resignation of Madhavan, a member of the royal murder investigation commission, blocked the investigation of the royal family in Nepal in 2001.
- **2002:** Pakistan rejected the proposal of joint patrolling on the Indian border in 2002.
- **2005:** Taiwan successfully tested its first cruise missile in 2005.

- 2008:** *America put India and China on the watch list.*
- 2013:** *Nawaz Sharif became the Prime Minister of Pakistan in 2013.*
- 2017:** *Successful launch of the heaviest rocket “GSLV Mark-3 D-1”.*

- 1723:** *Adam Smith, a British economist, philosopher, and author.*
- 1879:** *N.M. Joshi, the father of 'Trade Union Movement' in India, was born.*
- 1881:** *Govindrao Tembe, a harmonium player, stage actor, and music composer.*
- 1883:** *John Maynard Keynes, a British economist.*
- 1901:** *(A famous Malayalam language writer, awarded the Jnanpith Award) Govinda Shankar Kurup was born in 1901.*
- 1908:** *Ravi Narayana Reddy, a founding member of the Communist Party of India.*
- 1972:** *Yogi Adityanath, the 21st Chief Minister of Uttar Pradesh state, was born.*
