Important events of June 6

- 1660:** A peace agreement was signed between Denmark and Sweden.
- 1674:** Shivaji Maharaj was coronated in Raigad Fort and he also assumed the title of Chhatrapati.
- 1752:** A terrible fire broke out in Moscow, killing around 18,000 people.
- 1808:** Napoleon's brother Joseph was made the King of Spain on this day.
- 1831:** The second National Black Convention was held in Philadelphia, USA.
- 1833:** Andrew Jackson became the first president of the United States.
- 1850:** Levi Strauss made the very first pair of blue denim.
- 1882:** Electronic iron patented by Henry W. Seely of New York City. Back then, it named an electronic flatiron.
- 1916:** Women were given the right to vote in East Cleveland, America.
- 1918:** America got its first victory in the Battle of Belleau Wood during the First World War.
- 1919:** Finland declared war on the Bolsheviks.
- 1919:** The Prekmarg Republic was invaded by the Hungarian Red Army.
- 1944:** During the Second World War, the US Air Force began its air attack against Japan in by bombing the southern Japanese city of Focola.
- 1966:** James Meredith, the first black human rights activist to raise his voice against apartheid, was shot by a man at the University of Mississippi, USA.
- 1967:** Israeli forces captured Gaza in 1967.
- 1981:** A train fell into the Bagmati River in Bihar, killing about 800 out of the 1000 people on board.
- 1984:** One of the most popular video games, Tetris, was released for the first time in USSR.
- 1984:** Operation Blue Star ended. 576 killed, 335 injured.
- 2004:** Tamil was declared a classical language by the President of India.
- 1995:** In Pakistan, flogging or hanging of juvenile offenders was banned.
- 1997:** India, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka and Thailand formed an economic cooperation group called 'BISTEC' in Bangkok.
- 1999:** India's first pair Leander Paes and Mahesh Bhupathi won the tennis Grand Slam.
- 2002:** Israeli forces attacked Palestinian leader Yasser Arafat's headquarters in Ramallah.
- 2002:** the United Nations Security Council unanimously passed a resolution banning Al Qaeda.
- 2005:** Iran gas pipeline project agreed between India and Pakistan.
- 2007:** South African anti-apartheid leader Winnie Madikizela Mandela was barred from entering Canada.
- 2008:** The first BJP government in Karnataka led by B. S. Yeddyurappa won the trust vote.
- 2008:** The Japanese satellite Kibo began operating at the International Space Station.

- 1890:** *Gopinath Bordoloi, a politician and Indian independence activist who served as the first Chief Minister of Assam.*
- 1891:** *Masti Venkatesha Iyengar, a writer in Kannada language.*
