Important events of June 7

- •1413: King Ladislaw of Naples captured Rome.
- •1539: Afghan Sher Shah Suri defeated Mughal emperor Humayun in the Battle of Chausa in Buxar.
- •1546: England signed the Peace of Andres with Scotland/Ireland in 1546.
- •1557: England declared war on France.
- •1654: Louis XIV became the king of France.
- •1692: Three thousand people died in the earthquake that struck Port Royal in the Caribbean country Jamaica.
- •1780: Anti-Catholic riots broke out in London, leaving about 100 people dead.
- •1862: The United States and Britain agreed to abolish the slave trade.
- •1863: French forces captured Mexico City.
- •1864: Abraham Lincoln was nominated for the second time by the Republican Party for the presidency.
- •1893: Mahatma Gandhi first used civil disobedience in South Africa.
- •1928: Vatican City became a fully sovereign nation.
- •1929: *Vatican City became a sovereign country.*
- •1939: George VI and Elizabeth became the first British king and queen to visit the United States.
- •1948: The leftists completely took over Czechoslovakia.
- •1966: Sony Corporation introduced its new brand of video tape recorder.
- •1975: The first match of the first World Cup was played between India and England at Lord's Stadium in London.
- •1979: India's second satellite Bhaskara-1 was launched from Bears Lake in the Soviet Union.

- •1999: Immigration Rules 1999 prevalent in Sri Lanka abolished.
- •1999: The first democratic elections in Indonesia after 1955 took place in 1999.

- •2004: The Israeli Cabinet approved a proposal to remove settlements from the Gaza Strip.
