Important events of June 8

• World Brain Tumor Day & World Oceans Day

- •632 AD: Islamic prophet Muhammad died in Madina.
- •979: Louis V de Loye became Emperor of France.
- •1557: England declared war on France.
- •1655: Jews revolted against Rome.
- •1658: Aurangzeb captured the Agra Fort.
- •1707: After Aurangzeb's death, his two sons, Muazzam and Azam Shah fought for the throne of Delhi. In this, Muazzam killed Azam Shah and seized the throne of Delhi.
- •1786: The first commercial advertisement for ice cream was made.
- •1824: Noah Cushing patented the washing machine.
- •1830: German inventor Camberz invented matchsticks.
- •1855: Lisbon, the capital of Portugal, was completely destroyed due to a severe earthquake and the fire caused by it.
- •1869: The first vacuum cleaner was patented by Ivis W. McGaffey of Chicago.
- •1915: The book Gita Rahasya, written by Lokmanya Tilak while he was in Mandalay prison, was published in Gaikwad Vada, Pune.
- •1936: India's government radio network was renamed All India Radio.
- •1937: The world's largest flower bloomed in a botanical garden in New York City, America.
- •1940: The discovery of the 93rd element, neptunium, was announced.
- •1948: First international flight of Air India took off from Bombay to London. The flight was VT-CQP Malabar Princess.
- •1949: Siam's name was changed to Thailand.
- •1963: The American Heart Association (AHA) became the first agency to launch a campaign against cigarettes in 1963.
- •1968: The Constitution was adopted in Bermuda.

•1972: Former England cricketer Tony Greig made his Test debut against Australia.

•1975: About 35 people died in the collision between two trains in Munich, Germany.

•1982: Brazilian plane "B-727" crashed, killing approximately 130 people.

- •1984: Homosexuality became legal in New South Wales of Australia.
- •1986: Iraqi jets attacked the Asadabad satellite station.
- •1992: World Oceans Day celebrated for the first time.

- •1992: Mossad, the intelligence agency of the Zionist regime, killed another Palestinian official abroad to strengthen this illegal regime.
- •1992: World Oceans Day was celebrated for the first time in Brazil.
- •1997: India's Mahesh Bhupathi created history by winning the mixed doubles title at the French Open Tennis tournament in Paris.
- •1998: Honda had to pay \$17.1 million to remove pollution-control equipment from 1.6 million cars.
- •2002: The President of the Philippines ordered a campaign against the terrorist organization Abu Sayyaf.
- •2008: militants in southern Somalia shot dead a local journalist for the British Broadcasting Corporation.
- •2012: A bomb blast in a bus in Pakistan in 2012 killed 18 people and injured 35 others.
- •2013: American tennis player Serena Williams won the French Open title by defeating Maria Sharapova.
- •2014: Russian tennis player Maria Sharapova won the French Open title by defeating Simona Halep.
