Important events of July 11

- *World Population Day*
- **1346:** Charles IV of Luxembourg was elected the ruler of the Roman Empire.
- **1673:** Defence treaty between Netherlands and Denmark signed.
- **1801:** The French astronomer John Louis Pons discovered the comet, Pons.
- **1832:** British Parliament rejected the appeal of puritanical Hindus against the abolition of Sati.
- **1889:** Sova Bazar Club became the first Indian team to participate in a football tournament.
- **1893:** The first cultured pearl was obtained by Kokichi Mikimoto.
- **1896:** Wilfrid Laurier was sworn in as the seventh Prime Minister of Canada.
- **1921:** Mongolia gained independence from China.
- **1922:** The Hollywood Bowl opened.
- **1930:** Bradman scored 309 runs in a day against England at Leeds.
- **1948:** First air raid on Jerusalem.
- **1950:** Pakistan became a member of the International Monetary Fund (IMF).
- **1973:** 122 people were killed in a Boeing plane crash near Paris in Brazil.
- **1977:** Martin Luther King Jr. was awarded the Medal of Freedom.
- **1979:** The American space laboratory SkyLab fell to earth. It fell in the Indian Ocean and West Australia. Before it fell, speculations were being made all over the world about where it would fall on earth and how much damage it would cause.
- **1987:** The world population crossed the figure of five billion. The United Nations had decided to celebrate 11 July as Population Day.
- **1994:** Inspector General of Police Kiran Bedi received the Ramon Magsaysay Award.
- **1995:** Diplomatic relations between America and Vietnam were established.
- **1995:** More than 7000 people were massacred in Bosnia.
- **2002:** Chang Shang became the first woman Prime Minister of South Korea.
- **2003:** 'Dosti Bus' in Lahore and 'Sada-e-Sarhad' bus from Delhi started operating.
- **2004:** Asian Ministers' Conference on HIV-AIDS in Bangkok.
- **2004:** 7 railway bomb blasts took place in Mumbai suburbs.
- **2006:** Mumbai train bombings: 209 people were killed in a series of bomb attacks in Mumbai, India.
- **2007:** Famous painter M.F. Hussain participated as the chief guest in the New York art exhibition.
- **2008:** 11 people were injured in an American airstrike in Pakistan's Waziristan province.
- **2010:** In the final of the Football World Cup, Spain won the title by defeating Netherlands 0-1.
