Important events of June 30

- International Asteroid Day
- •1294: Jews were expelled from the Berne province of Switzerland.
- •1855: Santhal Rebellion started. The rebellion was led by the four Murmu Brothers Sidhu, Kanhu, Chand, and Bhairav.
- •1857: The Battle of Chinhat was fought between British forces and Indian rebels, at Ismailganj, near Chinhat, Oude.
- •1859: French acrobat Charles Blondin crosses Niagara Falls on a tightrope.
- •1868: Christopher Schleuss obtained the patent rights for the typewriter.
- •1870: Ada Kepley became the first woman to graduate from a law college in the US.
- •1876: Serbia declared war on Türkiye.
- •1888: Frederick Douglass became the first African-American to be nominated for the US presidential election.
- •1894: The International Olympic Committee was founded in Sorbonne Paris.
- •1894: Tower Bridge in London was opened.
- •1914: Father of the Nation, Mahatma Gandhi was arrested for the first time while agitating for the rights of Indians in South Africa.
