- •1783: Jacques Alexandre Cesar Charles made the first hydrogen balloon ascent, helped by the Montgolfier brothers, Jacques Etienne and Josef Michel. Source: National Air and Space Museum
- •1813: Napoleon defeated the allied army at Dresden. Source: Britannica
- •1859: The World's first oil well was drilled by Edwin Drake au Titusville, Pennsylvania. Source: <u>Drake</u> Well Museum
- •1928: The Kellogg-Briand Pact, an international agreement to condemn all war as a means of settling disputes, was signed by representatives of 15 nations. Ultimately 61 nations will sign it. Source: Yale University
